Dunaj, 13. okt. — Joseph Buerckel, nazijski komisar za Avstrijo, je v imenu nemške vlade čisto jasno povedal, da bo skušala nemška vlada vse, da zatire katoličanstvo, ali da mu vzame kolikor mogoče vpliva. Buerckel je govoril na Heldenplatzu kakih 100.000 oseb broječi množici, ki je divje pritrdjevala nazijskemu zastopniku, ko je udrihal po kardinalu Innitzerju. Buerckel je povedal, kako so katoliški politiki prosili nazijsko vlado, naj izpusti bivšega avstrijskega kanclerja Schuschnigga, ki je še vedno pod strogim nadzorstvom v hotelu Metropole. Buerckel je rekel, da se je pač nameravalo razmotrivati o usodi bivšega kanclerja, toda po zadržanju kardinala Innitzerja, ki se je postavil po robu nazijski vladi, ni zdaj o tem nobenega govora.

Z gotovostjo se trdi, da bo Hitler zahteval od Čehoslovaške, da se takoj odpove zvezi z Rusijo in malo antanto. Mednarodna komisija, ki je bila imenovana, da nadzoruje plebiscit v spornih krajih, je izjavila, da je dobila Nemčija vse, kar je zahtevala in da je zdaj vsak plebiscit nepotreben.

Že dolgo nas ni katera novica tako iznenadila kot vest, da je umrl dr. Jože Debevec. Prvič sva se videla s pokojnim dr. Debevcem pred 13 leti, ko sem bil pri prvem v Ljubljani. Dr. Franc Trdan me je seznanil z blagopokojnikom, katerega sem takoj vzljubil. Bil je vedno poln šal in kakor nalašč za družbo. Dasi mož velik po umu in učenosti, je bil vendar preprost in prijazen do skrajnosti. Ko smo se namenili, da gremo na Golico, je bil dr. Debevec takoj pripravljen narediti dolgo in težavno pot iz Jesenic na Golico peš z nami. Prišel je določeni dan. Kakih šest nas je bilo, ki smo ubrali pot pod noge. Vrh Golice se je blestel v krasnem jutranjem soncu. Meni se je videl prav blizu. "Boš že videl kako blizu je," mi je smehljaje odgovoril dr. Trdan, ki se je menda bal, da jo vrežem takoj nazaj, ko bi vedel pravo daljavo.

Pot se je vlekla, mi pa smo krevsali počasi pa neumorno naprej in v goro. Hodili smo komaj kako uro in pol, ko se je vrh Golice zakril.

"To je pa slabo znamenje," je rekel preroko dr. Debevec. "Ne vem, če bomo danes stopali po vrhu."

In res nismo. Ko smo se bližali sv. Križu, ki je nekako pol pota, je že začelo rosi. Iz rose je nastal dež, iz dežja ploha je plohlo in bili smo primorani kreniti v župnišče pri sv. Križu, kjer je takrat župnikoval Jože Kastelic, sedaj nekje v Argentini v Južni Ameriki.

Gospod nas je zelo gostoljubno sprejel, kot je to sploh navada pri ondodnih gospodih. Bili smo mokri, malo že utrujeni, pred vsem pa zelo razočarani. Večerjali smo, še malo posedeli in vsovali, potem pa smo se napotili spat v skedenj. Po dihanju sem spoznal, da so nekateri prav hitro pozabili vse, zazibal jih je spanec tako močno, da se je slišalo vse naokrog. Jaz nisem mogel spati. Tisti spak, "kranjska bolha," me je trpinčil celo noč. Poleg mene je ležal dr. Debevec. Kmalu sem opazil, da ima on prav take boje kot jaz. Oba sva potihem zabavljala čez bolhe, katere nimajo nobene manire. Končno sva začela pogovor, kateri je trajal čez polnoč, dokler ni spanec premagal naju, da sva pustila bolhe naj so grizle, kakor jim drago.

Pred tremi leti, ko sem bil v drugič tam, sva se z dr. Debevcem zopet srečala. Bil je še tak kot sem ga bil prvič spoznal, šaljiv, globoko zainteresiran za Slovence v Ameriki. Izpraševal me je tudi kako se kaj brat, Jaka Debevec, katerega vsa Amerika pozna, zdrži. Povedal sem mu, če verjamete al' pa ne, da je poln muh, sicer pa fejš dečko. Vesel je bil slišati tega.

In sedaj je odšel, odšel v kraj, iz katerega ni vrnitve, odšel je v večnost. Celo svoje življenje je delal v blagor bližnjega in za čast božjo. Gotovo mu ni žal, četudi je bilo večkrat težko zato, ker hvaležnosti primanjkuje na svetu. S sv. Pavlom je lahko rekel: "Dober bog sem bojeval, vero ohranil..." Bog mu daj mir in pokoj. Naj se izpočije od svojega neumornega dela. Bratom in sestram pa bodi tem potom izraženo naše resnično sožalje.

Probably no other month is so filled with events as is the month of October. It's the month of the Rosary, beginning with Rosary Sunday and ending up with the truly royal feast of Christ the King. We are also treated to such fine holidays as Columbus Day and Halloween. Speaking of the Rosary we have on hand an account of a new Religious Order founded in Ceylon, India. The article reads as follows: "One of the most important features of the life of the Rosarians is a devotion to our Blessed Mother. What particularly characterizes this Society is evident from their very name and their daily timetable. At four o'clock the Religious rise, recite morning prayers, and then chant five decades of the rosary. After the rosary, at five o'clock, they have three quarters of an hour of meditation followed by Mass. At seven o'clock they take breakfast. Manual labor and spiritual exercises fill up the rest of the day. Of these spiritual exercises, the principal one is the recitation of the rosary (in turn by pairs) before the Blessed Sacrament at every hour of the day and night. Once a day they chant the whole rosary in a Tamil melody." And should we who profess to love the Mother of God find it difficult to say five little decades each day?
