INCREASE IN FAMILY ALLOWANCES IN INDUSTRY

WHEREAS it has been deemed advisable and necessary to make provisions for an increase of 50% in the amounts of Family Allowances payable to industrial workers in respect of their dependent children in that part of Venezia Giulia administered by the Allied Forces,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAMES J. CARNES, Colonel, Infantry, Senior Civil Affairs Officer,

ORDER

ARTICLE I

NEW RATES OF FAMILY ALLOWANCES IN INDUSTRY

As and from the first pay period after the 30 September 1946, the rates of Family Allowances and contributions thereof, as set out in Table "A-1" annexed to Order No. 325 dated 5 March 1947 shall be revoked and in lieu thereof shall be substituted the following:

Order No. 405 (367 A)

INCREASE IN "INDEMNITY FOR BREAD" PAYABLE TO CERTAIN CLASSES OF PENSIONERS AND UNEMPLOYED WORKERS

WHEREAS pursuant to Order No. 367 dated 31 May 1947 a temporary indemnity for increased price of bread has been granted to certain classes of pensioners and unemployed workers; and

WHEREAS in consequence of a further increase in the price of bread, it is deemed reasonable and necessary to grant an increase in the daily rate of the said temporary indemnity in that part of Venezia Giulia administered by the Allied Forces,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAMES J. CARNES, Colonel, Infantry, Senior Civil Affairs Officer,

ORDER:

ARTICLE I

INCREASE IN INDEMNITY

As and from the 11th June, 1947, the temporary indemnity for the increased price of bread as provided for by Order No. 367 dated 31 May 1947, shall be fixed at Lire 13.—per day.

Order No. 406 (141B)

PROVISIONS RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL CONTRACTS

WHEREAS it is considered advisable and necessary to make certain amendments to the provisions contained in Order No. 141, dated 3 June 1946, concerning the Deferment of agricultural contracts and other provisions in reference thereto within that part of Venezia Giulia administered by the Allied Forces (hereinafter referred to as the « Territory »);

NOW, THEREFORE, I. JAMES J. CARNES, Colonel, Infantry, Senior Civil Affairs Officer, hereby,

ORDER:

ARTICLE I

ADDITIONAL LIMITATIONS UPON DEFERMENT

The following is herely added to Article III, of Order No. 141:

- «d) if the owner or any other person having the same rights, who was direct tenant farmer, states that he wishes to cultivate directly the land, and his family's working capacity is sufficient for the purpose.
- e) if the owner or any other person having the same rights states that he wishes a son of his, who was or is a direct tenant farmer, and whose family's working capacity is sufficient for the purpose, to cultivate the land directly.
- f) if the owner wishes to make on the land radical and immediate agricultural changes the carrying out of which is incompatible with the continuation of the contract and the plan of which has already been declared feasible and useful for the purposes of agricultural production by the Territorial Inspectorate of Agriculture».

ARTICLE II

INSERTION OF NEW SECTIONS IN ORDER No. 141

The following Sections are hereby inserted in Order No. 141 as a part of Article III:

«SECTION 2 — The owner or any other person having the same rights, who obtain the disposal of the land for the reasons specified in letters d), e) and f) of Article III hereof as amended by Order 406 and does not comply with the obligations assumed, must return the land and compensate the damages to the metayer (mezzadro), to the farmer (colono), to the crop-sharing farmer (compartecipante) or lessee (affittuario) to whom the deferment was denied.

SECTION 3 — Persons entitled to the deferment of the contracts in the cases considered by letters d), e) and f) of Article III hereof as amended may renounce to such right; the renunciation must appear from a written deed or from a statement made before the Judicial Authorities».

Order No. 407

PROVISIONS IN FAVOUR OF PERSONNEL OF THE JUDICIAL ORDER AND ATTORNEYS OF THE STATE

ORDER:

ARTICLE I

INCREASE OF "DI TOGA" INDEMNITY

Without any prejudice to the payment of the other indemnities paid at present, under whatever title, to the Magistrates of the Judicial Order and to the Lawyers and Attorneys of the State, the "di toga" indemnity in favour of same is hereby fixed at the following monthly gross rates:

ARTICLE II

PAID OVERTIME WORK

Without any prejudice to the other provisions contained in Orders Nos. 217 and 284, and with regard to extraordinary work actually performed, the magistrates of the Judicial Order and the personnel of the Judicial Offices ("cancellerie e segreterie giudiziarie") may be paid the compensations for overtime work up to a maximum of sixty hours monthly, regardless of their grades.

This Order shall take effect within the Territory on the date it is signed by me, and the provisions contained therein shall be effective as from 1 February 1947.
