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NATO zavezniki se ne morejo sporazumeti o trgovini s komunisti

Amerika predlaga omejitev dajanja kreditov Sovjetiški zvezzi na pet let, Anglia jih je pripravljena raztegniti na 15 let.

CLEVELAND, O. — Politični in gospodarski krogi se ne morejo sporazumeti in najti skupnega odgovora, ali je dovoljeno trgovati s komunističnimi državami in, če je, pod kakšnimi pogojimi. Naši deželi je navadno zmagalo politično stališče in odločevalo, kakšna naj bo trgovina s komunističnimi državami. Seveda nismo pri tem postopali zmeraj enako. Za Rusijo in njene satelite je veljala taktika omejevanja, za Jugoslavijo smo pa bili zelo širokogrudni. Na drugem koncu je v Angliji zmagalo gospodarsko stališče, izraženo v geslu: vse, kar ni izrecno prepovedano, je dovoljeno. Ostale države so nihale med ameriškim in angleškim stališčem, kar je rodilo pravo zmenjavo v trgovski politiki svobodnega sveta s komunističnim.

Krediti za 15 let so dejansko gospodarska pomoč

Vsaka zmenjava je dvorenemec, ki ga je v gospodarskih stvareh čutil ves svobodni svet. To je bil glavni povod, zakaj so članice NATO napravile poskus, da se sporazumejo vsaj v tem, kako naj svobodni svet kreditira dobave komunističnim kupcem. Na sestanku v Parizu, ki se je vršil pretekli teden, ni bil dosežen noben sporazum. Amerika in države Evropske gospodarske skupnosti so predlagale, naj bi Zahod dajal komunistom kredite največ za pet let, Anglia se je temu uprla in predlagala 15 let. Z njim so potegnile Danska, Norveška in Kanada.

Tekma v kreditiranju se bo torej začela in ne bo poznala meje. Za večino kreditov, ki jih dajejo podjetja, navadno prevezemo jamstvo njihove države. Izvozniki torej ne tvegajo, da so lahko širokogrudni na prim komunistom. Moskva je dobila na ta način že nad billion dolari posojil, zvezanih z uvozom industrijske opreme iz svobodnega sveta. Ta vsota bo sedaj nitro rastla.

Združeni narodi bodo povečali uradne prostore

ZDRAŽENI NARODI, N.Y. — Generalni tajnik ZN je razložil delegatom načrt, kako naj bi se na sedanjem primeroma majhnem prostoru dali povečati uradni prostori. Sedanji so postali pretesni, posebno manjka manjših dvoran za seje odborov in komitetov.

Ko so delali načrte za sedanje stavbe, niso računali, da bo število članic ZN tako visoko naraslo. Thant ceni, da bodo investicijski stroški znašali \$11.3 milijonov. Kako jih bodo ZN krili, še sam ne ve.

V Argentini dosežen začasen sporazum med vlado in rafinerijami

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Že pred par dnevi je od nekod prisla novica, da se delo v ameriških rafinerijah in naftnih vrelcih ni ustavilo in da gre svojo pot naprej. Sedaj jo je dopolnila novica, da je bil med vlado in rafinerijami dosežen začasen sporazum, ki omogoča rafinerjam, da obratujejo do nadaljnega po dosedanjih pogojih.

To bi tudi odgovarjalo smislu tretje novice, da so namreč za kulisami na delu razni posredovalci, ki predlagajo, naj se odnosi med rafinerijami in vlado uredijo na način, ki je podoben sporazu v Indoneziji ali pa v Iranu. Tak sporazum bi v glavnem dal argentinski vladi odstotno najmanj toliko dohodkov, kolikor jih imata iranska in indoneziska vlada.

Na dobičku bi bila udeležena argentinska vlada s 60%, obenem bi pa tudi dobivala naftne izdelke, posebno pa bencin, po produkcijskih cenah, ki bi bila v njih vračanana tudi amortizacija dosedanjih investicij.

To je najbrže tudi razlog, zakaj je Kennedy sicer močno kritiziral posopek argentinske vlade in grozil s posledicami, da pa ni mit z besedom omenil konkretnih korakov, ki jih namenava napraviti.

V Venezueli nasilje še zmeraj naraščajo

CARACAS, Venez. — Teroristi, ki jih vodijo in oborožujejo domači komunisti in Castrovi pristaši, so prešli v splošno ofenzivo. Kar imajo aktivistov, vse so poslali na ulice, da tam streljajo, mečejo bombe, uničujejo z dinamiton javna poslopja itd.

Ceprav jim policija in vojsko stopata odločno na prste, ne odnehajo v svojem divjanju, ki že kaže svoje posledice na vsakdanje življenje. Vlada je iz previdnosti ustavila začasno potuk v ljudskih šolah. Trgovine skušajo obravnavati čim manj časa na dan, gospodinje se zalagajo z hrano, ljudje se umikajo z ulic, vsakdo se drži najraje doma. Pa še tam nimajo miru, teroristi so organizirali grožnje po telefonu. Neznani ljudje klečijo mirne stanovance in jim grožijo "s posledicami", ako se ne bodo ravnali po njihovih navedilih. Obtičal je deloma tudi avtomobilski promet. Teroristi so namreč posejali prometne ulice z ostrimi žeblji in razbitim steklom.

Teror ne divja samo v Caracasu, ga je dosti tudi v pokrajinskih in industrijskih središčih. Vendar pa predsednik Be-tancourt ne popušča. Hoče izvesti 1. decembra predsedniške volitve, čeprav ve, da bodo teroristi divjali do zadnjega dne in motili tudi voliven postopek, kjerkoli ga bodo mogli.

Vse to je imel gotovo pred očmi naš predsednik Kennedy, ko je pretekli ponedeljek rekel v svojem govoru v Miami, da naša dežela ne bo dopustila, da bi služe "tujeju komunizmu" prevzemali oblast v ameriških republikah.

RUSI POGNANI IZ KONGA

Kongoška vlada Cirila Adule je proglašila vse se danje osobje sovjetskega poslanstva v Kongu za "nedobrodošlo", ker da je sodelovalo z nemimi nasprotniki, pri tem je izjavila, da ne misli prekiniti diplomatskih odnosov s Sovjetsko zvezo.

LEOPOLDVILLE, Kongo. — V torek so kongoške oblasti prijele svetovalca sovjetskega poslanstva Borisa Voronina in tiskovnega atašaja Jurija Miakotnika, ko sta se vračala iz Brazzavilla, kjer naj bi se bila sestala z nasprotniki Adulove kongoške vlade. Rusa sta se upirala izročiti svoje aktovke in bila pri tem celo tepena. Naslednji dan so oblasti prijele še nekega ruskega časnika v mestu Leopoldville. Včeraj je kongoška vlada objavila, da je osobje sovjetskega poslanstva sodelovalo z nemimi nasprotniki v cilju, da vrže zakonito vlado dežele. Zato je vse osobje poslanstva proglašila za "nedobrodošlo" v Kongu, kar pomeni, da mora v 48 urah zapustiti deželo. Vlada Cirila Adule je smatrala za potrebno objaviti, da s tem ne smatra, da bi bili diplomatski odnosi Konga s Sovjetsko zvezo prekinjeni. Voljna je sprejeti novo sovjetsko zastopstvo, ki ne bo kompromitirano.

Kongoške oblasti so izjavile, da so doble pri obetu prijetih luskih diplomati dovolj dokazov, da sta se v Brazzavillu sestala z nasprotniki vlade, ki želijo dobiti od Sovjetske zveze 5 bilijonov ponarejenih kongoških frankov, s katerimi bi ti finančirali boj proti vladi Adule in seveda tudi uničili zaupanje v kongoško valuto. Prav tako bi do Sovjetske zveze radi dobili orožje in razne druge potrebsčine za obsežnejše podtalno delovanje, sabotaže in vohunjene. Kljub vsemu so ju izpuštili in ju z ostalimi pognali iz dežele. Skupno imajo 30 let trenutno v Leopoldvillu okoli 100 svojih ljudi všeči žene in otroke.

Sovjetska poročevalska služba je izjavila danes, da sta sovjetska diplomata še vedno zaprti. Sovjetska vlada je že v torek ostro protestirala pri vladi Konga in zahtevala takojšnjo izpuštiev. Sovjetsko časopisje je sporočilo javnosti, da sta bila Rusi prijeti od kongoške policije, ki so jo vodili 'ameriški svetovalci'. To se pravi, da naj bi bile za nastopom kongoške vlade proti poslanstvu Sovjetske zveze v Leopoldvillu — Združene države.

V Kongresu ravno sedaj obravnavata pristojni odbor zakonski predlog, ki naj naloži predsedniku obvezo, da proglaši 1. januarja kot "leto oglejte si Ameriko".

"Oglejte si Ameriko, toda ne vse!"

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Državno tajništvo je prepovedalo diplomatom petih satelitskih držav, da ne smejo obiskovati nekaterih delov naše dežele. Površina teh predelov znaša 11% vsega našega ozemlja. Ker smo dežela svobode, je proti temu takoj protestiralo nekaj prizadetih okrajev, češ, da jih je tak odlok "ponižal" v očeh naše domače javnosti. Obenem tudi zahtevajo, naj bo naša narodna obramba dosti spremna, da bi lahko vse skrila pred očmi pretirane komunistične radevosti.

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Tito: njegova pota in politika

Tito je dosegel l. 1955 vrh svoje politične karijere. Dooma je postal neomejen gospodar. Ne v stranki, ne zunaj nje mu nihče ni delal več takih težav, ki bi ogrožale njegov osebni in politični položaj. Res je, da ni bil takrat in ni še danes zadovoljen z vsem, kar se tam dogaja, toda vse smatra samo za običajne ovire na njegovih potih v socijalizem. Radi njih ne bo komunistična diktatura v Jugoslaviji propadla. V mednarodnem svetu mu je pa obisk tovarišev Bulgarian in Hruščeva pomagal do političnega ugleda, ki daleč presega političen, gospodarski in vojaški pomen njegove dežele.

Političen ugled še ne pomeni ne osebnega slovesa ne ravnopravnosti v družbi in javnosti. Političen ugled samo odpira vrata do predsednikov vlad in držav, jamči za običajne uradne medsebojne stike med mogočniki tega sveta, daje prilike za uradne obiske in vabilna nanje, ne ustvarja pa osebnih stikov s politiki in javnimi delavci, ki niso ravno povezani z vladami in režimi, ne gradi mostov do "ulice", ne rodi resničnih simpatij, recimo, "ljudskih množic". Je dober samo za uradne stike in redne politične posle. Ocenjen sloves je čisto nekaj drugega. Dvigne politiko nad vsakdanjo politiko, mu ustvarja spoštovanje in simpatije tudi tam, kjer ne vlada politika, ga približuje navadnemu človeku, mu odpira srca tudi tam, kamor seže samo opis njegove osebnosti.

Političen ugled in oseben sloves uživajo samo politiki, ki živijo v svetu svobodne demokracije. Njim so zato odprta vrata na vse strani, ne samo v uradne in politične prostore. Potovanja naših predsednikov doma in v tujini so nazoren primer, kaj pomenijo kot politiki in osebnosti, kjer koli se pokažejo. Diktatorji kaj takega nikdar ne morejo doseči. To tudi dobro vedo, toda so med njimi tudi izjeme, na primer Tito.

Tito si je l. 1955 vbil v glavo, da mora biti spoštovan in priljubljen po vsem svetu, kamorkoli bi ga pot pripeljala. Ne tako zelo kot na primer Eisenhower ali Kennedy, pa vendarle. Če ga je prišel Hruščev častit v Beograd, zato kaj ga ne bi tudi ostali svet. Imel je in ima prav v toliko, kolikor mislimo na tiste države, kjer vlada diktatura. Tam si lahko zagotovi tudi osebno veljavno, seveda le v uradnih krogih. To je tudi vse, kar more doseči, kajti zunaj diktator tako nihče ničesar ne pomeni. Ni torej za Tita zanimivo in pomembno.

Tito je takrat mislil, da so mu odprta vrata v javnost tudi v svobodnem svetu. Ko je hotel priti l. 1956 v našo deželo na obisk k Eisenhowemu, je spoznal, da stvar ni tako enostavna. V Ameriki sta predsednik in njegov režim ena stvar, javnost in javno mnenje pa druga. Spoznal je tudi, da sam obisk pri Eisenhowemu ne pomeni dosti, ako ga ne odobrava javnost. Zato je sklenil, da poskusi vse, da pridobi na svojo stran tudi javnost, ne morda samo v Ameriki, ampak v vsem svobodnem svetu. To se da doseči na različne načine. Tito je preskusil skoraj vse.

Po l. 1956 ni varčeval ne z delom ne s potovanji ne z denarjem, da se dokopljde do takega osebnega ugleda v svetu, da ga bo javnost v vsaki deželi, kamor bi prišel na obisk, sprejela z odprtimi rokami. Vabil je od vseh strani politike, časnikarje, znanstvenike, umetnike, športnike, pisatelje na obisk Jugoslavije, vsakemu je priredil sijajen sprejem, vsakemu se je laskal, vsakega je hotel pridobiti s svojim nastopom. Njegov režim je vabil delegacije, depurtacije, je prirejal mednarodne konference, sestanke, teme in kongrese kar na tekočem traku. Stroški niso pri tem igrali nobene vloge. Vsak domač jubilej je okrasil s tujimi gosti, na vsako domač slavnost so bili pozvani tudi zastopniki tujine. Razume se, da hočejo biti gostje tudi hvaljeni, imajo pa pri tem tiko željo, da jih hvaljenost ne obremeniti preveč. Zato jo po možnosti omejujejo na besede, pisane in govorjene. Te so najcenejše, so pa obenem slavospevi, navadno vsebinsko zelo prazni, toda to nič ne de. Vsaka beseda napravi vtis, če je še tako banalna, le do stikrat jo je treba ponavljati. Na to je ravno Tito računal. Vsi njegovi gostje so mu peli hvalo, včasih odkritosčno včasih hinavsko. Toda, kdo bi se za razliko kaj menil? In tako je šel po svetu sloves, da je Tito dober človek, moder politik, uvideven državnik, uspešen državni poglavlar, napsotnik čiste komunistične ideologije, oboževatelj stvarnosti, ki je več vredna kot komunizem.

V vsem tem je nekaj resnice, toda ne toliko, kolikor jo je o Titu naslikala njegova propaganda. Kot vsak diktator, je tudi on postal njena žrtva. Prišel je do zaključka, da svoboden svet sicer ne mara za titozem, da mu je pa on sam kar simpatična osebnost, ki ima pravico do ravnopravnosti v vsaki svobodni družbi, ne samo politični. Zakaj ga trej ne bi Kennedy sprejel tako slovesno in prijateljsko kot Hruščev? Saj med njima ni nobene razlike!

Po obeh Amerikah mu je moralna zopet odpreti oči, vsaj tako upamo. Moral je spoznati, da je vsej v svobodnih ameriških republikah tam, kjer je bil l. 1956. Vladni krogi

so ga povsod sprejemali, kot se spodobi, toda mraz je vladal v odnosih med njimi in tistimi, ki so ga gostili. Uradna prijaznost tekem sprejemov in razgovorov ni mogla zbrisati dejstva, da leži med njim in tistimi, ki so ga sprejemali, nekaj, kar ni v redu. Cutilo se je povsod, da so v zadrugi, kadar se morajo pokazati z njim v javnosti. Javnost je namreč ob vsaki priliki pokazala, da ne mara zanj; in to vsa, ne samo begunska.

Za nas, ki živimo v svobodnem svetu, je razlog jasen. Tito nosi osebno odgovornost za vse zločine, kar jih je naredila po l. 1941 njegova komunistična stranka. Tito je kot komunist nasprotnik vseke svobode, ne samo politične. Ne napada je naravnost, ampak po ovinkih. Hoče za diktaturo ravnopravnost s svobodo. Na svojem potu po Ameriki ni niti enkrat pohvalil svobode! To sta razloga, zakaj ga javnost v svobodnem svetu ne mara.

Tito se je vrnil razočaran s svoje poti po Ameriki. Ni dosegel na njej tega, za kar se je trudil od l. 1956 naprej. Ne vemo, če hoče verjeti razlogom za svoj neuspeh. Spoznati jih je moral, ni tako omejen. Ali bo te nauke kaj vpošteval, bomo kmalu videli. Če ne ob drugih prilikah, bo gotovo govoril o novem družbenem planu za l. 1964 in za novo petletko. Govoril bo gotovo tudi o novem proračunu. Morda nam bo takrat povedal, kaj si je sedaj postavljal kot cilj svoje zunanjne politike.

Vsaka beseda napravi vtis, če je še tako banalna, le do stikrat jo je treba ponavljati. Na to je ravno Tito računal. Vsi njegovi gostje so mu peli hvalo, včasih odkritosčno včasih hinavsko. Toda, kdo bi se za razliko kaj menil? In tako je šel po svetu sloves, da je Tito dober človek, moder politik, uvideven državnik, uspešen državni poglavlar, napsotnik čiste komunistične ideologije, oboževatelj stvarnosti, ki je več vredna kot komunizem.

THANKSGIVING DAY is truly an American custom and holiday which has not lost its meaning since its beginning more than three centuries ago.



The final stages of construction are being financed by a \$40,000 "faith" loan from a Marion, Ill., bank. Presley, a retired mail carrier from Makanda, Illinois, said "we should be deciding soon on a dedication date." The cross is expected to be completed soon. More than 60,000 persons have contributed to the cross of peace in Southern Illinois, which eventually will be floodlit and visible at night from miles away in all directions.

Part of the money was raised — \$60,000 — by Illinois farmers from pig sales. The cross will have cost some \$250,000 when it is finished. Bald Knob mountain is the scene of annual Easter sunrise services. Salem, Oregon. — Oregon's department of employment, which tries to find jobs for the jobless, can't pay 100 of its own employees and is laying them off. What's more, said David Cameron, commissioner, the remaining 650 are expected to take pay cuts. He said a 1½ percent cut in the 1963-64 federal budget for aid to state employment services was responsible.

The Cleveland Indians announced the signing of righthanded pitcher Jim Rittwage, 19-year old prize product of Bedford, Ohio and the Cleveland sandlots.

In making the announcement G. Paul, Indians' president and general manager, also stated that Rittwage had received a very substantial bonus to sign with the Tribe.

Rittwage, who had been sought by nine other major league clubs, pitched this past summer for the Bedford Go team and had a 9-2 record, including eight complete games. His earned run average was an excellent 1.34.

The six-foot-three-inch pitcher in 67 innings of work allowed only 10 earned runs and 38 hits. He registered a pair of shutouts, walked but 22 men and struck out 89 batters, an average of more than one man per inning.

Rittwage, who was scouted by Cleveland area scout Paul O'Dea and recommended by Hall of Famer Elmer Flick, will be assigned to Charleston (W. Va.) roster of the Eastern League, a Class AA farm affiliation of the Indians.

Rittwage, a mainstay of the Bedford Go team in the Cleveland NABF, Jr. division, sparked the team to the National tournament in Youngstown during the last week in August. Bedford was ousted after three games, never losing by more than two runs.

The Go team won 20 and lost only seven during the season and Rittwage's nine victories represented almost one-half of the team's total victories.

Cleveland Indians' President Gabe Paul announced that he has received the signed contracts of coaches George Strickland and Elmer Valo, bringing the entire field management staff under contract for the 1964 campaign.

Other contracts already agreed to include that of new pitching coach Early Wynn. Manager Birdie Tebbetts will be starting the second year of a three-year agreement with the Indians.

G. Strickland, who handled the third-base duties last season, will begin his 14th year in professional baseball and his third as a coach. Valo, a professional player for 21 seasons, is starting his second year as a coach and Wynn, 300-game winner, will be an inactive player for the first time in 28 years of professional baseball.

Including the career of Tebbetts, the Cleveland field staff has a total of 87 years of baseball experience.





Accent On Peace

The lights are burning long and bright in the United Nations General Assembly, which someone has called the "closest thing we have to a parliament of man."

Some 80 items — large and small — are on the agenda of this new 18th annual session, which will run well into December. Foremost among them are disarmament, decolonization, and peace-keeping — all hardy perennials traditionally debated with some heat.

This year, though, the conciliatory General Assembly speeches of President Kennedy and Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko give hope

that "cold war" animosity will not dominate the 111-nation conclave. There is other business most delegates would rather concentrate on — other problems they'd rather tackle.

So there was a heartening sound to the President's stress on building a better world through scientific cooperation, disease detection and prevention, war on illiteracy, human rights, freedom from hunger and the U.N. Development Decade to raise mankind's living standards generally.

As one delegate remarked: "These are not things that make headlines, but they are the ones that count."
