KAIRO, 12. julija. — Ojačeni angleški tanki in topništvo je danes popoldne z vso srditostjo udarilo v previdno zasnovanem anevru na ozadje armade osi. Na čelu nemškega maršala Rommela.

Bitka je trajala še pozno v noč. Odločitve, od katere je najverjetneje odvisna usoda angleške in nemške vojske, je pričakovati v nekaj dneh.

Bojestranski napadi izvedeni v pravem trenutku. Maršal Rommel je udaril na angleže ob pravem času, ko so mele angleške čete polno afriško sonce v oči, skoro istočasno pa so udarili Angleži na njegovo ozadje, tako da so imeli tudi Rommelovi vojakovi sonce v oči. — Obe strani sta vrgli v boj vse moči, ki so jim na razpolo.

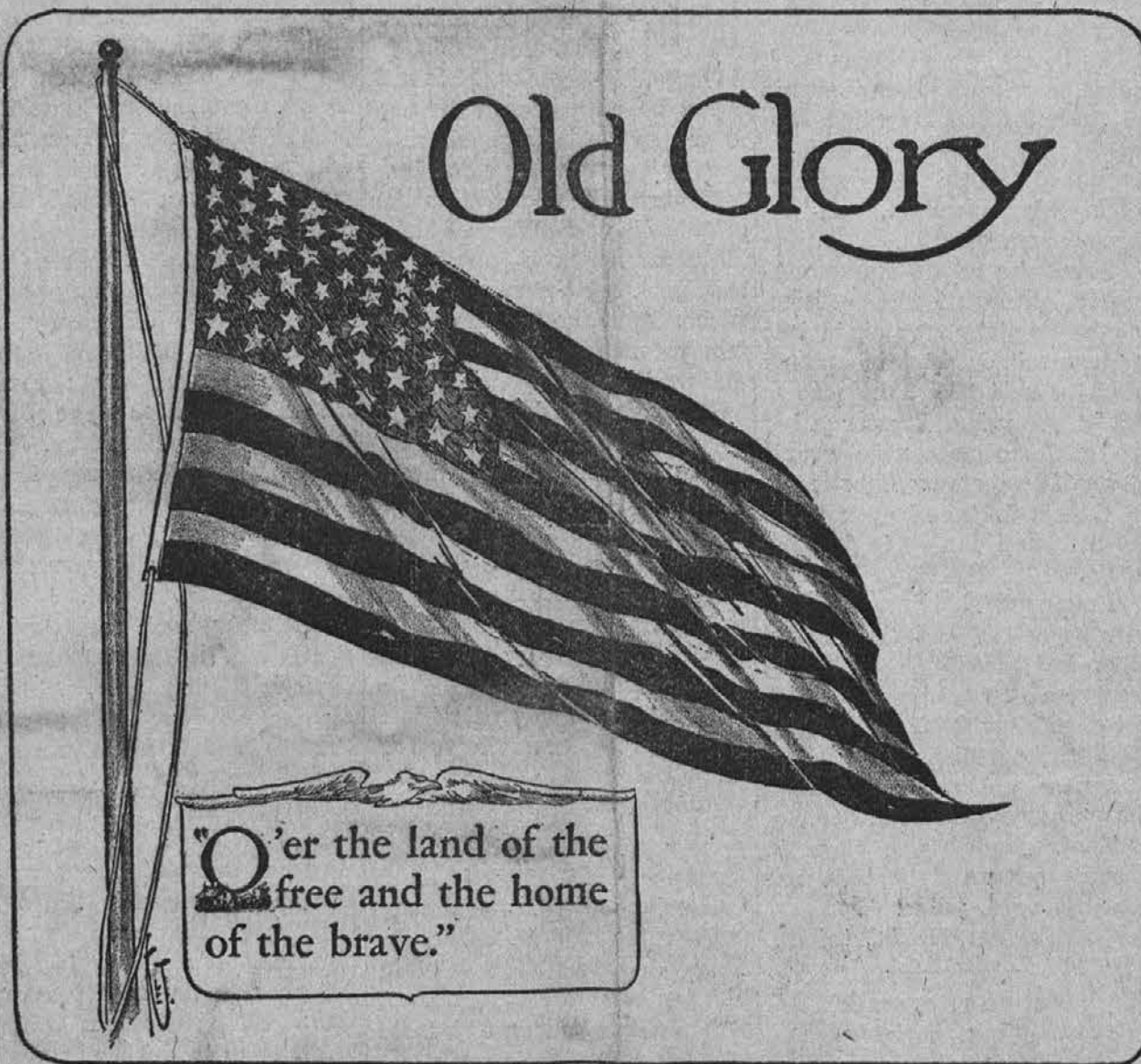

MOSKVA, 3. julija. — Rusi so naznanili danes zjutraj, da se vrše v predmestjih Sevastopola srđiti boji na nož, dočim so Nemci že v sredo javili, da je Sevastopol padel. Na severu pa so pričeli nacisti novo ofenzivo v Belgorod—Volčansk odesku.

Poročila naznanjajo, da so junaki brambovci Sevastopola že pobili tisoče napadalcev, odkar so Nemci javili zavzetje te močne trdnjave, in da je napadalcev petnajstkrat več kakor brambovcev.

Srdita bitka tankov

Ruske tankovske čete se bijejo v srđiti bitki tankov v okoličici Kurska, Nemci so pa razširili polje svojih operacij tudi v Belgorod—Volčansk okraj. Belgorod leži 50 milj severno, Volčansk pa 35 milj severno-vzhodno od Harkova, ki je še vedno v nemški oblasti.

Rusi s hrptom ob morju

Na kurski fronti je bilo tekom 24 ur ubitih najmanj 7,000 Nemcev. Glede bojev za Sevastopol pravi Rdeča zvezda, da se Rusi bore s sovražniki na treh straneh in s hrptom ob morju.

Ruska črnomorska mornarica, v kateri sta tudi dve moderni križarki, in sicer Rdeči Krim in Rdeči Kavkaz, operira zdaj iz drugih pristanišč ob kavkaški obali.

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IZJAVA NEODVISNOSTI

Praznik Izjave neodvisnosti ni bil morda v Clevelandu še nikoli tako svečano praznovan kakor bo praznovan jutri, ko se bodo udeležile te proslave vse v Clevelandu zastopane narodnosti. In prav je, da se ga svečano praznuje, ker morda je baš ob tem času narodom najbolj pojmljiv smisel svobode in neodvisnosti, ki je je čedalje manj že skoro pri vseh narodih Evrope in tudi ostalih kontinentov.

Amerika odgovarja na zasužnjevanje narodov z močnim obrambnim programom, da se obvaruje pred napadom in zasužnjevanjem. Na isti način je mala skupina voditeljev na drugem kontinentalnem kongresu sklenila podpirati Washingtonovo armado in obrazložila potrebo tega postopka z Izjavo Neodvisnosti, ki je osvobodila kolonije od tiranske nadvlade.

Neodvisnost sama je bila dosežena dne 2. julija, 1776, ko je Kontinentalni kongres sprejel resolucijo št. 1, ki jo je predložil že dne 7. junija Richard Henry Lee iz Virginije, in v kateri je bilo naglašeno, "Da so te Združene kolonije svobodne in neodvisne države; da se smatrajo odvezane vsake pokorščine do angleške krone; in da so prekinjene vse politične zveze med njimi in Veliko Britanijo."

Nato je bil izbran poseben odbor, ki naj pripravi izjavo ali deklaracijo v soglasju z omenjeno resolucijo, nakar je bila ta izjava dne 4. julija prebrana in sprejeta.

Kakor rečeno že v uvodu, je ta Izjava Neodvisnosti letos še mnogo bolj pomembna, zato je tudi primerno, da se ta naš veliki praznik ameriške neodvisnosti in svobode čim dostojneje praznuje. K sodelovanju so letos pozvane zlasti vse narodnosti v Clevelandu, ki bodo s svojo navzočnostjo pokazale, da znajo ceniti neodvisnost in svobodo in da jim oboje ni prazen pojem.

AMERIKA SE PRIPRAVLJA

Amerika je vojno resno vzela in uspehi se že kažejo. Po računih izvedencev, bo ameriška industrija že tekom tega leta dala zavezniškim silam nadmočje nad totalitarci v vojnem materialu, ki je v sedanji mehanizirani vojni odločil. Ogromne količine vojnih sredstev se že sedaj izlivajo iz ameriških tovarn v Avstralijo, v Rusijo in Veliko Britanijo. Do konca tega leta bo v Ameriki zgrajenih za osem milijonov ton prevoznih ladij; vsak dan leti iz Amerike v Anglijo 25 velikih bombnikov in številni lovci podmornic narašča vsak dan. Skratka: Amerika dela s polno paro vojna sredstva, ki naj čim prej strejo totalitarne sile. Z izredno vnemo brusi Amerika sekuro, ki bo vojno odločila.

Ko to čitamo, se spominjamo, kako je Hitler lansko leto tolažil nemški narod, da bo ameriška pomoč demokratičnim državam pridelala prepozno. Takrat je še upal, da bo mogel pred koncem leta 1941 narekovati Evropi mir. Danes mu gotovo od strahu trepeče srce, ko iz "arzenala demokracije" prihajajo do njega jekleni zvoki mrzlične delavnosti, pomešani z žvenketom orožja z vzhodne fronte.

Huda prede. In tega se ne zavedajo samo nacistični kolovodje v Berlinu. Tako računajo tudi v manjših prestolnicah, kjer žive vlade, ki so se dale vpreči v totalitarni voz. Madžarska se na vse načine izmotava, naj za ofenzivo proti Rusiji, eno izmed zadnjih kart, s katero še nekoliko igrajo nacistični veljaki, pripravi čimveč čet. Nič večjega uspeha ni imel Hitler z Bolgarijo; poslušati je moral, kako mu je koburški Boris razlagal, da bi sodelovanje bolgarske vojske na ruski fronti moglo bolj koristiti Rusom kakor Nemcem. BOB FELLER

A new record crowd for baseball, one that even will surpass the \$0,200 established when the Cleveland Indians opened the Cleveland Stadium to baseball in 1935, is predicted for next Tuesday night, July 7th, when the United States Service team meets the winner of the annual American vs National league all-star game in a spectacle being staged at the Stadium for the Army and Navy Relief Fund.

The prospect of Bob Feller, star Cleveland pitcher, leading his team of soldiers, sailors and marines against the greatest galaxy of major league stars in the game, brings promise of a "standing room only" sign for the Tuesday game.

The team which wins the American vs National league all-star game in New York Monday is the team which will face Feller and his mates. Included in the lineup of the Service team will be such outstanding big-league stars as Sam Chapman of the Athletics; Johnny

Sturm, Yankees; Cecil Travis, Senators; Frankie Pytlak, Red Sox; John Lucadello, Browns; Don Padgett, Cardinals; John Rigney, White Sox and Mickey Harris, Red Sox.

In addition to the ball game, colorful pre-game ceremonies are on the schedule with music by service bands, marching units of the Army, Navy and Marines and demonstrations overhead by Army flyers.

Jack Dempsey, now a lieutenant in the Coast Guard and Gene Tunney, a commander in the Navy, who once drew a \$2,000,000 gate when they fought for the world's heavyweight boxing championship, will be on hand to add color to the spectacle. They will be introduced to the fans.

Because of the length of the pre-game program, the evening's entertainment will get underway at 7 o'clock. Prices of tickets for the game are only \$2.55 for reserved seats, \$2.10 and \$1.85 for grandstand seats and \$1.55 for bleacher seats, all prices including \$1.00 worth of stamps which go to the purchasers of tickets.

CZECH MINISTER CHARTS POSTWAR ROLE OF SLOVAKS

"The future of the world depends on the Anglo-American and the Slav peoples," Dr. Milan Hodza, prime minister of Czechoslovakia during the Munich crisis, told an audience of 700 at the Czech Sokol Hall gardens, 4314 Clark avenue, on Sunday, June 28.

Dr. Hodza's appearance in Cleveland was sponsored by the National Slovak Society's "Hviezdoslav" unit of Greater Cleveland. The society's headquarters are in Pittsburgh.

Dr. Hodza warned Americans of Slovak descent not to believe the statements of the Slovak "Quislings" now ruling in Bratislava and who in turn are ruled by the Nazis.

"I fully expect Slovakia to participate in the formation of a future Czechoslovakia and that in the new setup Slovakia, will have its own legislative body, as guaranteed by the last act of the former Czechoslovak republic before the Germans occupied the country," he said.

Dr. Hodza bitterly condemned the sending of Slovak troops against Poland in 1939 by the Bratislava Slovak government of Joseph Tiso. He also assailed the Nazi-Hungarian "conspiracy to rob Slovakia of its eastern territory."

Vatro J. Grill, assistant police prosecutor, represented Mayor Frank J. Lausche as speaker at the affair. Former Judge Geo. S. Tenesky was chairman of the meeting.

Feighan vs. Sweeney

The Democratic voters of the 20th Congressional District in Ohio are called upon to perform a task at the forthcoming primary election which has long been overdue: defeat Martin L. Sweeney, who has misrepresented the sentiments of the district ever since the Hitler menace became a matter of serious concern of thinking people everywhere.

Michael A. Feighan, former Democratic leader of the Ohio House of Representatives, is the man who should be elected in Sweeney's place.

Mr. Sweeney's record of opposition to President Roosevelt's efforts to prepare America for the inevitable showdown with Hitlerism is long and consistent. He never missed an opportunity to act as "one of Hitler's little helpers in the Congress of the United States." His by no means small political talents have always been at the disposal of those who tried to make America weak and unprepared. He has been a faithful ally of the isolationists and the anti-New Dealers in and out of Congress. If he and his kind had been successful in blocking President Roosevelt's defense program, Pearl Harbor would have found America completely at the mercy of her enemies.

It isn't a question whether or not Mr. Sweeney, like every other citizen, has a right to his opinions in regard to the foreign policies of the Roosevelt Administration. No one denies him that right. The point is that his opinions have been demonstrated as one hundred per cent wrong. In view of that, his retirement to private life becomes necessary for the good of the country. If he didn't know better, he is guilty of unexcusable ignorance. If we knew better, and in spite of that followed the course his record reveals, then, he is guilty of something immeasurably worse.

Latest Labor Laws Put in Booklet Form by Consumers' League

To acquaint the thousands of new workers now entering war industries with their legal rights, the Consumers' League of Ohio announced publication of a 32-page pamphlet containing up-to-the-minute state and federal labor legislation in streamlined form.

Entitled "Your Rights as an Employee" the booklet is a revised edition of the League's 1941 version, and includes legislative changes in workmen's compensation, unemployment compensation, and wage rates in the Federal Wage-Hour law.

The pamphlet which is simplified in detail for the layman has sections devoted to state and federal wage laws, state and federal hours laws, child labor, working conditions, forbidden work for women, social insurance, and labor disputes.

Civic and governmental agencies where workers can obtain legal information and aid are listed under each law and on the inside of the back cover of the booklet which sells for 10 cents.

"The League believes that the understanding of these laws on the part of workers, employers, and the public is essential to the fulfillment of their purpose," Elizabeth S. Magee, executive secretary of the Consumers' League, 341 Engineers Bldg., Cleveland, said in announcing publication of the pamphlet, "and therefore we are anxious at this crucial time to distribute the booklet as widely as possible."

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John Tercek, Veteran Slovene Editor Dies

John Tercek, editor of the Glas Naroda Slovene daily in New York City, died last Sunday, June 28, at his home in North Bergen, N. J., at the age of 51. The deceased came to America in 1912 and became an assistant editor of the paper in the same year.

The disease which finally became fatal first attacked Mr. Tercek six years ago, and he was ever since victim of great suffering. In spite of that he continued to write and was active with the paper almost to the day of his death. In January of this year his right leg was amputated below the knee.

Mr. Tercek was a talented writer, and he was at his best when writing in the humorous vein. His column, "Peter Zgaga," which appeared daily in the Glas Naroda, was widely read and enjoyed by Slovenes throughout the United States.

He is survived by his wife and three sons. His body was laid to rest on July 1.

Yugoslav quarters here said Mihailovitch's forces seized several planes when the Germans invaded Yugoslavia and hid them until fuel could be obtained. They reportedly obtained gasoline by trading Italian prisoners for it.

Three historic flags will be carried at the July 4 Festival of Freedom Saturday night in the Stadium, Common Pleas Judge Frank C. Merrick and George Buehler, co-chairmen of the festival committee, announced today.

One flag is that of the U. S. S. California which was hit in the Pearl Harbor attack by the Japanese. The companion Union Jack of the same boat will also be carried in the parade. The latter will be carried by the Marines and the former by Navy men.

Another historic flag to be displayed will be that which was carried to Europe by the Lakeside Unit Hospital, the first unit to reach Europe in the First World War.

The third historic flag will be one which flew over the grave of Francis Scott Key, author of the Star-Spangled Banner, in Frederick, Md. This flag will be carried by 7-year-old Ruth Louise Hancock of 10103 Columbia avenue.

William Ganson Rose, master of ceremonies and Miss Dorothy Whitney, program director, today predicted that Clevelanders will see at the Festival of Freedom the greatest group of massed American flags ever to be flown in Cleveland.

Theodore Andrica, chairman of the nationality pageant, announced two more nationality groups will participate in the pageant. They are the Austrian, with Frank Strasek and Frank Streit, chairmen, and the Norwegian with Thorleif Hansen, chairman.

LIDICE TO LIVE AGAIN IN ILLINOIS TOWN

An unincorporated Illinois town which is 90 per cent Slavic or of Slavic descent will be renamed July 12 for the Czechoslovak town, Lidice, which was destroyed by the Nazis, and a fund to erect a liberty monument there is growing fast.

Stern Park Gardens, near Joliet, is the town and its renaming is designed to reincarnate the original Lidice. A committee of 150 prominent persons in the midwest has been collecting the liberty fund.

The monument will contain a flame which will be kept burning to symbolize the light of liberty which America is determined to preserve. The American Czechoslovak Chamber of Commerce and the United Council of Czechoslovak Legionnaires have endorsed the renaming and the fund.

Mayor Lausche Meets King Peter of Yugoslavia

The Cleveland Press on day of last week reported: King Peter II of Yugoslavia has a cordial invitation to Cleveland, delivered by Mayor Lausche, who said he seeks to have the State Department, which arranged the forthcoming tour, alter it to include this city.

Mayor Lausche met the king informally last week trip to Washington, introduced by the Yugoslav minister, stantin Fotich.

"He is a charming, young person, utterly without ostentation or pretense, and he has a predisposition to humor which is most enjoyable," the mayor said.

The conversation ranged over three languages — English, which the king speaks with a clipped British accent; Slovenian, and Serbian.

Serbian, Too
King Peter, keenly interested in the mayor's statement both his parents were born in Yugoslavia, inquired also in Serbian. "I do, but I don't know the language go," he replied. "We are interested in hearing me," replied Mayor Lausche.

The king laughed heartily, but the conversation proceeded in Serbian. Mayor Lausche's mother was born Velike Lasec and his father Kranj. They came to America at the age of 16 and 17, respectively, settling in Cleveland.

When Mayor Lausche spoke in praise of Gen. Draja Mihailovitch, whose Yugoslav troops were harrying the Nazi armies, the king replied: "We are interested in the work he is doing."

Cites Slovenian Popularity

"Just a day or two ago, I advised some people who wanted to know more of the background of that situation to read 'Mountain Wreath' by Blaz Njegosh," said the mayor. "The monument to this author in the Yugoslav Cultural Garden here."

"The Yugoslavs of Cleveland and all America were elated by your repudiation of adventurism who would have had Yugoslavia join the Axis," the mayor said to the king.

"I received many gratifying messages from America," Mayor Lausche replied.

Pressing his invitation to visit Cleveland, the mayor said this city "has a larger Slovene population even than Ljubljana," the capital of Slovenia.

"I think you are probably right," agreed Peter. The conversation turned to golf, at which the mayor is good. "There is a course at Bled, in Slovenia, where summer palace is situated. I have happy memories of place, although I do not know it well," the king said.
