Nekaj časa nazaj sem poročal o proslavah tridesetletnice, katere prirejajo naša društva po raznih krajih Ohia in Pennsylvaniji, in katerim sem imel posebno priložnost, ter se osebno zanimanju in navdušenju za stvar, ki ga izkazuje članstvo, dasi ga še vedno kriza in dasi je večidel velika revščina, ki je slediti dolgotrajnemu in gospodarski depresiji v Pennsylvaniji. Naša društva po Penni pa tudi ne spe in nočejo zastonj nobeni dobri stvari, po kateri ne, kadar gre za koristno in v našem glasilu izdajemo na častnem mestu vredne besede.

sta in ne preveč vabljivih prilik za zapravljanje denarja in ljudje tudi drugače žive precej skromno, zato so si nekateri neverjetno veliko prihranili. Pa so prišli agentje s sladkimi besedami in dobro namazanimi jeziki (Jugoslovani, seveda) in jim prodali razne delnice, največ pa ničvredna zemljišča kje v oddaljenem kraju in za drag denar.

Družina Bratkovich se je lotila farmarstva ter si poskuša z obdelovanjem zemlje pomagati skozi krizo, toda letos jih tepe suša in je tudi na farmi težko življenje. Slišal sem še o par drugih slovenskih farmarjih tam v bližini. Br. Relich pa se je preselil v bližnje mesto Oil City, kjer je prevzel pekarno in jo uspešno obratoval več let, toda težko delo ga je začelo zmagovali in po odpravi prohibicije je dobil dovoljenje za trgovino z likerji, edino v istem mestu. Oil City ima vsepolno rafinerijo za olje, ki jih lastujejo skoraj izključno potomci nekdanjih nemških priseljencev in noben tujec ne dobi tam dela. Relich je menda edini priseljenec v tistem mestu, vsaj tako sem slišal.

Relichova družina je kljub oddaljenosti zelo aktivna pri društvu, posebno br. Relich, ki je zmogel in dobra pomoč društvenim uradnikom.

Društvo ima v bratih Stimac, Žagar, Cvetkov in Bratkovich dobre predstavnike in agilne uradnike, toda slabe razmere jim zaenkrat onemogočujejo pridobivanje novih članov in večji razmah društva, upajo pa trdno, da se bo kmalu obrnilo na bolje. Govorili smo tudi o organiziranju mladine v angleško poslušajoče društvo, katere je tam precej in obljubil so, da bodo delali za uresničenje sprožene misli ter organizirali mladinsko društvo kakor brž bo mogoče.

Nezadovoljni rudarji so ustanovili novo organizacijo, da se iznebe Lewisia in lewisizma, pri čemur so naleteli na odpor tudi pri operatorjih in državnih oblastih.

Stavka za zaprtje delavnice. Fall River, Mass. — Šeststo delavcev je zastavkalo pri American Thread kompaniji za enforširanje zaprte ali unijske delavnice. Stavkarji so člani tekstilne unije in so po dvatedenski suspenziji obrata odklonili delati z neunijskimi delavci.

Unijske zahteve so: odprava nadurnega dela in dvojnega šifra, zvišanje plač do \$50 za operatorje in \$40 za "kleklatarje" (knitters) na teden in znižanja števila strojev na delavca. Arzenalni delavci so pa zagrozili s stavko radi upiranja družb za sklenitev kolektivne pogodbe. Sploh so do zdaj zavrgle vse sugestije za skupno konferenco. United Dry Docks Co. in Todd Shipyard družba sta očividno v zaroti proti unijam ladjegradniških delavcev, ker stalno kršita v novembru sklenjeni dogovor in početa nič slišati o kakršnih pogajanjih za izravnavo spornih vprašanj.

Gl. odbor gl. porotnega odseka. Zadeva društva št. 13. Br. Anton Bobnar, član društva št. 13, Bridgeport, Ohio, se je bolniški listi do 16. februarja 1934. Glavni bolniški odbor pa mu je na podlagi porotnega odseka izpričeval odklonil izplačilo bolniške odprave; zdravniško spričevalo izkazuje, da je prišel do bolniškega pretepu. What? No Dictatorship

Every now and then some "liberal" Capitalist will declare that we are not (the God!) living under a dictatorship.

Well, we have not yet reached the stage where people may not speak their mind in every state in the union which is in final syndicalist laws ready for use against individuals when necessity decrees. Nor are we in a legal method of righting all wrong except in such states as disfranchise women because of color and other considerations, yet have we witnessed brutal executions, vicious imprisonment—except, of course Calumet, Ludlow, Dayton, San Francisco many other localities, and in the case of Sacco and Vanzetti and Tom Mooney and such.

No, compared to Germany and Austria Italy we're fairly free to do anything we like except we be unreasonable enough to lie, work and support our families under conditions which are not profitable to a small class.

But workers are fooling themselves if they think that the bright star of freedom is all going to retain even its present tinsel lustre.

There is a reason why the screws have been put upon unionists and Socialists in America to the same degree as in other countries. It is because the American people are receptive to their masters' brand of "republican" Europeanism. Here, somehow, we take is given us and are more grateful—for the erable doles, for the disgraceful code minimum and for the presidential softsoap.

Masters need not be brutal to slaves. The rule they're not—until the slaves rebel. when the workers of any nation not only for, but attempt to take, more than their ploiters are willing to give—well, then no tyranny which will crush the spirit of revolt has been considered excessive.

Following the revolt of Spartacus against slaves, the roads to Rome were ablaze with light cast by human torches who dared to fight for freedom. More recently modern Italy, many and Austria have furnished demonstrations of the fact that the masters still are ruthless. In America the dictatorship of Capital is less vicious because the serfs of Italy are not offering a serious threat to the existing economic order. But just let the erican slave dare strike for freedom . . . let him dare!—Reading Labor Advocate.

The Big Strikes

Friends of the New Deal have often said that the epidemic of labor strikes is proof there is recovery. "Labor strikes when they are getting better, not when they are getting worse." Now there is a small element of truth in this, but of course it is not true that strikes because it is well off. It strikes because it has been outrageously exploited strikes with increasing fervor because learning that no Blue Eagle but only penny will get it any approach to justice. Big strikes in Minneapolis, Toledo, Milwaukee and San Francisco have all shown a great solidarity labor.

The unemployed have shown real solidarity by the support they have given to strikers. They do not take their jobs, they help. Even the police for various reasons have shown in some of the strikes a surprising degree of friendship to the strikers. That, I am told, was the case at Toledo and some extent in Milwaukee during the short and successful trolley strike.

By the way, Socialists must not let themselves be misled by the police situation in Milwaukee. Dan Hoan, the Socialist Mayor, and the strikers of the Socialist Party have had a whole influence on the Police Department, but Police Department in Milwaukee is not controlled by the Mayor because he cannot renege the Police Commissioner.

At present the bitterest and most despised strike in the country against terrible conditions is in the onion fields near Toledo, Ohio. I am proud to hear of the role that the Socialists in Toledo are playing in that strike. They are financial and other help, which either through the National Office or I shall be glad to pass on to them.—Norman Thomas.
