Male države pred ZN

Vodniki malih držav se izražili za podporo ZN in za neutralnost v borbi med obema svetovnima taboroma.

NEW YORK, N. Y. — Z zaporednim odrhajanjem vodilnih državnikov izgublja skupščina Z d r a ž e n i h narodov na pomenu in zanimivosti. V plemarnih sejih nastopajo poglavari manjših držav.

Predsednik vlade Libanona je predlagal spremembe v organizaciji, ki bi dale zastopnikom manjših držav več mest v odborih, zlasti v varnostnem, gospodarskem in socialnem odboru. Zavrgel je sovjetski predlog o spremembah glavnega tajništva in zahteval naj Združeni narodi izvedejo v Alžiriju ljudsko glasovanje o tem, ali ljudstvo te dežele hoče biti s Francijo ali ne.

Grški zunanjji minister je pozival vse posamezne države, naj prepuste rešitev razmer v Konžu Združenim narodom in je izrazil popolno zaupanje v generalnega tajnika.

Za Maroko je govoril prestolonaslednik Moulay Hassen. Svetoval je, naj nove članice ne vstopajo v nikak bllok velikih sil, da bi mogle bolj nepristransko pomagati k rešitvi težke napetosti, ki vlada v svetu. Maroko bo ostal neutralen in nepristranski, a dal po vso podporo Združenim narodom.

Stalni delegat Španije in predsednik vlade Nove Zelandije sta močno podprla glavnega tajnika osoobno in odločno zavrnila sovjetski predlog, naj se tajništvo razdeli med tri osebe.

Nekaj novega razpoloženja je prišlo z nastopom delegacije Nigrije, ki jo vodi predsednik vlna de sir Abubeker Tafava Balewa. Ta delegacija bo zastopala najmočnejšo afriško državo in zasenčila dosedanje kandidata za vodstvo Afrike, predsednika Gane in Gvane. Nigerija je že povedala da bo podpirala glavnega tajnika, da se bo upirala sovjetskim predlogom in da bo postala svoj del vojaških sil v Kongu. Nigerija bo osto napadala Južno Afriko, oziroma njeno vladilo, ki ne priznava črnem nobenega vpliva na državne posle.

Po volitvah obnova preskusov A-orozja?

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Če ne bo v Ženevi prišlo v kratkem do kakih rešitev, ki bi pokazala, da je sporazum o končanju preskušanja atomskoga orozja v bližnjih bodočnosti verjeten, bodo ZDA po volitvah izvede vrsto podzemskih poskusov, ki naj pomagajo najti boljši način odkrivanja takih preskusov.

Vojški krogi so ponovno predložili obnovno preskusov čes, da jih Sovjetija nemara tuo vrši. Radi bi preskusili učinkovitost in delovanje raznega maha atmoskoga orozja.

HAVANA, Kuba. — Vlada je objavila, da so oblasti za petami preostalim 24 vpadi kom, ki so se v sredo izkrcali na vzhodnem robu otoka.

Tito maščevanje nad piketi predloženo ZN

Jugoslovanske oblasti so nastopile proti sorodnikom piketov v Jugoslaviji.

NEW YORK, N. Y. — Demonstranti proti Titu tekem njegovega bivanja v New Yorku so se obrnili na Državno tajništvo in tajništvo ZN s pritožbo, da so jugoslovanske oblasti nastopile proti sorodnikom piketov v Jugoslaviji. Pritožbo je predložil predsednik Ameriško-srbskega odbora George Waughn.

Vaughn je izjavil, da je najmanj devet Jugoslovanov v New Yorku dobile v zadnjih dneh pisma, telegrame in v dveh slučajih celo telefonske kllice o maščevanju jugoslovanskih rdečih oblasti nad sorodniki demonstrantov v Jugoslaviji.

Jugoslovansko zastopstvo pri ZN je pritožbo označilo za "obrekovanje, ki ni vredno odgovora."

Lausche za guvernerja, DiSalle za senatorja?

COLUMBUS, O. — V krogih vodstva demokratske stranke ugibajo, če ne misli Frank Lausche I. 1962 kandidirat ponovno za guvernerja, med tem ko bi se naj za mesto zveznega senatorja pognal sedanji guverner Michael DiSalle.

Svoja ugnjanja utemeljujejo s trditvijo, da se Lausche v Washingtonu ne počuti posebno dobro in z dejstvom, da obiskuje vneto razne velesejme in razstave po Ohio, kot je to delal v preteklosti, kadar so se bližale volitve za guvernerja.

Strajk pri General Electric se še razširil

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Mednarodna unija električnega delavstva je razširila štrajk proti General Electric Co. z včerajšnjim dnem tudi na največjo podjetje družbe v deželi, na tovarne v Schenectady, N.Y.

Krajevna organizacija v tem podjetju se je prvotno odločila proti štrajku, pa se mu pri ponovnem glasovanju pridružila.

GE je zavrnila ponudbo unije za novo pogodbo. Razgovori med predstavniki družbe in unije v zadnjih dneh niso spora približali rešitvi. Štrajk na splošno mirno poteka.

GE ima v vsej deželi 166 tovarn s skupno okoli četrt milijona delavcev in ostalih uslužencev. Od tega jih je v Mednarodni uniji električnega delavstva (IUE) okoli 70,000.

Cleylandska cerkvena dostojanstvenika se vozita v Italijo z isto ladjo kot Josip Broz-Tito, predsednik FLRJ.

Sovjetija bo pomagala Indiji utrijevali mejo

Sovjeti zveza se v novi pogodbi z Indijo, ki bo podpisana v bližnji bodočnosti, zavezuje pomagati graditi prometno mrežo ob indijsko-kitajski meji.

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Indija

in Sovjetska zveza sta sklenili pogodbo, ki predvideva, da bodo Sovjeti dali Indiji veliko pomoč za zgradbo železniške mreže in drugih prometnih zvez, ki jih misli graditi v severnem delu države, v pokrajinalah, ki meje na dečo Kitajsko.

Dasi pogodbo označujejo kot trgovsko, izgleda, da ima tudi svoj politični pomen. Sovjetska zveza bo namreč po tej pogodbi pomagala, da se Indija okrepi v tistih svojih pokrajinalah, kjer je najbolj ranljiva od strani rdeče Kitajske.

Sovjetska zveza bo dobavila Indiji gradbene stroje, letala, helikopterje za vrednost \$31,500,000.

Ni nikaka tajnosti da se Indija neče zavarovati pred napadi s strani rdeče Kitajske, s kakišnimi je imela opraviti lansko leto. Ozemlje ob meji je sedaj težko dostopno in onemogočuje prevoz in vzdrževanje večjih vojaških jedinic z indijske strani.

Po Titovem obisku v Ameriki

Tito je kar na tihem odpotoval na laški ladji nazaj v Evropo. Novica o njegovem odhodu je bila objavljena slučajno skoraj isti čas kot Eisenhowerjev negativen odgovor na željo nevralcev, da se sestane s Hruščevim.

Mislimo, da se je to res zgodilo slučajno, vendar pa le po osvetli pokop Titovih želja v mednarodni politiki.

Tito je prišel 20. septembra v Ameriko s polno torbo žeja in načrtov. Upal je da bosta v newyorški in ameriški javnosti, preko nje pa tudi v mednarodnem političnem svetu, njegova prisotnost in beseda veliko zaledli v njegovo osebno čast in v korist Jugoslavije. Računal je, da se mu bo posrečilo, da s svojimi prijatelji ustvari vsaj skupino, ako že ne blok nevralnih držav-članic Združenih narodov. Upal je, da ga bo Eisenhower povabil v Washington in da mu bodo tam odprta vsa vrata. Upal je tudi, da se bo mogel pogovoriti o marsičem s tovaršem Hruščevim.

Vsi ti upi so se mu izpolnili v malem obsegu ali pa sploh nič.

Najprvi je Tito moral spoznati, da je New York ljudsno morje, ki pogoltne vse, kar mu pade v roke. Na njem morejo svetiti samo politične zvezde prvega razreda, vse drugo utone, kakor hitro se pokaže na obzoru. V New Yorku se za Tita ni nihče zmenil, akoravno so delali zanj nekateri ameriški časnikarji čedno reklamo in propagando. Za newyorški političen svet je bil Tito samo eden izmed mnogih politikov, ki so prihiteli semkaj, da pristavijo svoj lonček; kam, še sami niso dobro vedeli. Vsi so se urezali in Tito z njimi vred. Kadar so se pojavili v javnosti, so bili muhe enodnevnice, ako niso hoteli uganjati takih nenavadnih burk kot Hruščev in Castro.

Pri vsem tem je Tito napravil še to nerodnost, da je začel protestirati proti piketiranju. Ni vedel, da piketiranje ne krade v Ameriki nikomur časti in da pomeni samo poseben način opozicije, ki v drugih krajih ni v navadi. S protestiranjem proti piketiranju se je samo osmešil.

Tito je moral vse to čutiti, kajti v javnosti se ni pokazal, vrtl se je samo v diplomatskih krogih, ki so blizu ZN. Osebnih zvez z ameriškimi politiki, ki kaj pomenijo in bodo kaj pomenili, ni iskal. Ni imel tudi nobenih tiskovnih konferenc, ki bi padle v oči.

Vse svoje delo je posvetil ideji o formirjanju nevralnega bloka v okviru ZN. Ko je prišel sem, je takoj spoznal, da v Ameriki pomeni oseba ravno toliko kot ideja in da on sam ni oseba, ki bi v mednarodnem svetu lahko zastopal velike ideje. Usodo svojega dela za nevralni blok je moral zato navezati na indijskega Nehruja, ki pa za ta posel ni bil nič kaj navdušen. Tito je s čakanjem na Nehruja in na pogajanja z njim potrošil večino svojega časa. Pri tem so mu šli na roko indonezijski Sukarno, egiptovski Naser in ganski Nkrumah. Vsa ta pisana družba je končno pridobila Nehruja, da je pristal na predlog resolucije ZN, naj se Eisenhower in Hruščev zopet začeta osebno pogovarjati.

Ideja o resoluciji je bila precej otročja. Je kar prezrla, kako se Hruščev obnaša in kako drži besedo. Je hotela narediti na Eisenhowera moralni pritisk, naj se pogovarja s Hruščevim in pozabi na vse skušnje, ki jih že ima z moskovskim diktatorjem. Je prezrla vsaj teoretično možnost, da bi se Eisenhower in Hruščev mogla sporazumeti tudi na račun nevralcev in si jih porazdeliti med seboj kot vplivna področja. Lepo bi gledal na primer Tito, ako bi se Eisenhower in Hruščev sporazumela, da naj Tito spada pod Moskvo. Zato lahko razumemo, da je Eisenhower idejo nevralnega bloka kratkomalo odbil, ne morda kar na svojo roko, ampak po posvetovanju z londonskim in pariško vlado. Eisenhowerevo stališče je obenem politična blamaža za očete resolucije, ki bodo odgovornost za resolucijo valili drug na drugega. Morda je bilo to tudi povod za hiter odhod jugoslovanskega diktatorja, kajti svet misli, da se je on najbolj gnal za resolucijo.

Ideja o nevralnem bloku je dobila s tem hud udarec. Verjetno je za nekaj časa pokopana. Kaj bo Tito delal ta čas v mednarodni politiki? Saj bo vsakdo pri njegovem imenu takoj mislil na propalo resolucijo v ZN.

Tito je upal, da bo lahko navezal veliko osebnih stikov z vrhovi naše federalne administracije. Ni mu bila sreča dana, da opravi to delo. Pogovor z Eisenhowerm je bil kratek in formalnega značaja. Tito pač ni mogel povedati Eisenhowemu, kaj je bistvo spora med Moskvo in Peipinsgom. Vse drugo je Eisenhowera le malo interesiralo. Okoli Tita so se vrtili samo tisti ameriški diplomati, ki imajo poklicno delo z Jugoslavijo in to je bilo tudi vse. Značilno je, da je Eisenhower povabil Tita, naj si ogleda Ameriko, samo prestolje pa pri tem ni omenil. Tito je dalje iskal zvezne največ z azijskimi in afriškimi politiki, z diplomati iz Evrope in obeh Amerik je imel samo slučajne sestanke. Na zunaj se to da lepo utemeljiti, toda na drugi strani pa ta oko-

liščina pove, kakšen kredit uživa sedanja Jugoslavija ravno v kulturnih in naprednih državah.

Eno se je Titu bolj posrečilo, kot je mislil in želet. Hruščev ga je obilil s tako prijaznostjo, da je to vsem padlo v oči, Titu pa postalo skoraj v nadlego. Sestajal se je s Titom javno in z kulismi, pozdravljal Titove ideje tako očitno, da so mnogi začeli misliti, da se za Titovo nevralnost skriva dvojna igra. Zato so se začetne ameriške simpatije za Tita nenadoma zelo ohladile. Zakaj se je na primer Tito potegoval za resolucijo, ko je moral vendarle vedeti, da bo resolucija Hruščevu v veselje, Eisenhowerju pa v zadregu? Ali je to pametna nevralnost?

Na drugi strani moramo podprtati dejstvo, da je Titu Amerika odprla oči v marsikaterem pogledu. Moral je spoznati, da ima svobodni svet svojo logiko in da se ne da opearhariti z lepimi besedami. Spoznal je osebno vse njegove kandidate za nevralni blok. Dvomimo, da ima o njih najboljše mnenje. Vse to bo vplivalo na jugoslovansko zunajpolitiko in verjetno tudi na domačo. Sprememb v rezimu obisk ne bo povzročil, pač pa bo marsikateri tovaris moral gledati, da se obdrži na dosedanjem mestu. Tisti, ki bo morda najbolj prizadet po obisku, bo Titova "nova klasa".

Kako bo vplival Titov obisk na odnose med Ameriko in Jugoslavijo? Ena stvar je jasna. Ne drži Nixonova teorija, da je treba Tita podpirati, ker je neodvisen od Moskve. Recimo, da je to res. To pa še ne pomeni, da Tito lahko meče v znamenju aktivne nevralnosti pesek v kolesje ameriške zunajpolite. Tito omejuje svojo nevralnost na objektivno presojo ameriške in ruske politike. Kam pa pri tem usmerja svoje simpatije? Očitno ne na tisto stran, ki mu je ideološko sovražna. Simpatije pa igrajo v politiki veliko vlogo. To ve tudi Amerika, čeprav morda Tito misli, da je zaverovana samo v dolarje.

Amerika je svoje vrste svet. Ne živi samo od denarja, ima tudi nekaj svojih idej, ki so komunistom težko razumljive, kot so bile Hitlerju in Mussoliniju. Upajmo, da bo Tito na to opozoril tudi Hruščeva in ga skušal pripraviti k pameti. S tem bo mednarodnemu miru koristil veliko več kot z agitacijo za aktivno nevralnost.

BESEDA IZ NARODA

Važne spremembe v dočebah Social Security zakona

Cleveland, O. — Letos je bilo uvedenih v Socialno zavarovanje (Social Security) več važnih sprememb, ki zadevajo tudi večje število naših rojakov. Tako na primer za prejemanje zavarovalnine za delo nesposobne ni več omejeno na starost 50 let. Dobe ga lahko tudi mlajše osebe, če morejo dokazati, da za delo resnično, niso sposobne. Povečane so tudi podpore za otroke. V glavnem so važne sledeče spremembe:

1. Vzdrževalnina more biti priznana za delo nesposobnim delavcem, ki so bili zavarovani v okviru Social Security zakona, neoziraje se na njihovo starost. Doslej je bilo treba čakati najmanj do 50. leta starosti.

2. Z novim letom bo večina prejemnikov pokojnin, ki so zaposleni, plačevala manj od svojega zasluga.

3. Otroci umrlih delavcev bodo prejemali tri četrtine pokojnine, ki bi jo prejemali njihovi predpisani.

4. Stari vdovci, katerih žene so bile zaposlene in so bile zavarovane v okviru Social Security vsaj eno leto in pol ter so umrle pred 1. 1950, so uprabičeni do social Security pokojnin.

5. Nove dolobe so v nekaterih primerih skrajšale do zavarovanja, ki so omogočile zavarovanje do pokojnine.

6. Do zavarovalnine imajo sedaj pravico tudi preživelimi zavarovancev, ki so umrli pred 1. 1940. Vdova delavca, ki je umrl po 31. marcu 1938, pa je bil zavarovan vsaj eno leto in pol, ima pravico do pokojnine.

7. Starši, ki delajo za svoje si-

Proti naravnvi svili

Stari zapiski povedo, da so se Indijci že pred pet tisoč leti oblačili v bombaž, Kitajci v svilo, Egipčani pa v lan. Umetno svilo, ki so jo iznašli leta 1921, izdelujejo po kemičnih postopkih iz celuloze, torej pretežno iz lesa. Izprva so menili, da umetna svila ne bo mogla tekmovati z naravnimi svilenimi vlakni, zdaj pa kaže, da je za umetno svilo po zaslugu kemije napočil veliki čas, ki se je začel s sintetičnim vlaknem, katerega poglavita sestavna dela sta premog in apno.

Že pred drugo svetovno vojno so začeli izdelovati vlakna iz polivinilnega klorida. Če bi hoteli opisati pot od premoga in apna do umetnega vlakna, bi morali začeti pri procesu destilacije. Premog se spreminja v katran, ta pa v olja, iz katerih pridobivajo fenol. Med nadaljnjo destilacijo pridobivajo iz črnega ali rjavega premoga nadzadje soli podobno kristalno snov "kaprolaktam".

Dederon je drugo vlakno v sedanji veliki družini raznih umetnih snovi. Iz njega izdelujejo umetno svilo. Njegov prednik polivinil klorid je odporen proti kislinskim in solem, ne trohni in ne gori, razen tega pa dobro izolira toplosto. Zato uporabljajo tkanine iz te snovi za zaščitne obleke, za izolacijski material, za posteljne odeje, tako imenovano protirevmatično perilo itd.

Ta spisek bi bil znatno daljši, če bi ne imela vlakna iz polivinilnega klorida tudi slabih lastnosti, predvsem sorazmerno nizkega tališča. Že pri temperaturah nad 70 stopinj Celzija nastajajo na tkaninah iz polivinilnega klorida kakovstne spremembe. Pri tej temperaturi se vlakno krči in mečka.

Kaj pa je volkrilon? To je bel prah, ki iz njega s predelavo pridobivajo visoko. Na prvi pogled je volkrilon zelo podoben pravi volni, po kakovosti pa jo celo prekaša. Tkanine iz volkrilona so lažje in toplejše od tistih iz prave volne, odporne so proti vremenskim spremembam, kar pomeni, da se ne mečkajo in se ne krčijo, razen tega puščajo zrak in se naglo sušijo, pa tudi molji jim ne morejo do živega. Ta vlakna uporabljajo za izdelavo trikotaže, za ročno pletenje, za izdelavo umetnega krvna ter oblek vseh vrst.

Najnovejše sintetično vlakno se imenuje lanon, ki pa ga še ne proizvajajo v komercialne namene. Ker so tkanine iz lanona zelo močne in se ne meče-







C.**THE FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY PROGRAM IN OHIO.** The 86th Congress is now a matter of history and its accomplishments, or lack of them, will be continually discussed and analyzed for sometime. During the session I have attempted to keep you advised of various action taken by the Congress as well as other happenings in our Federal government. Since there will be no further Congressional action until January, it no doubt would be of considerable interest to examine the effect of some of the action taken in this session that affects our own State of Ohio. One such item is the Federal Aid to Highway Construction Program.

The amount of money available to Ohio this year for all highway construction will be approximately 5 per cent greater than last year; and it is, I think, reasonable to assume that the allocations made to the various counties from the State will be greater also than for last year. There are four general classes of highways that receive Federal aid: the interstate system, and what is usually described as the A.B.C. system in the State. There are 1489 miles on the interstate system authorized in Ohio consisting of two main east and west routes, two south and north routes, and a diagonal route from Cincinnati to Cleveland. These are limited access highways and the Federal government pays 90 per cent of the cost of construction. About \$121 million will be available for construction of this system this year.

The next category is what we describe as the primary system, more commonly called the "A" system. These are U. S. numbered routes and some of the more important state highways. Examples are U. S. routes 3, 23, 30, 35 and 50. There are 9,000 miles of such roads in Ohio and approximately \$13 million of Federal funds have been allocated to Ohio for next year, which must be matched by the State on a 50-50 basis.

The next category, called "B" roads, are the county highways, frequently called secondary roads, which largely serve the rural area.

New Changes in Social Security

The 1960 changes in the Social Security laws contain seven major amendments. These changes will affect thousands of persons living in Cuyahoga County.



One of the amendments, regarding disability, will bring benefits to an estimated 1,300 disabled workers and their families living in this area. Increased payments will also go to about 4,000 children in and around Cleveland, according to A. W. Boehringer, manager of the Cleveland East Side social security office. Also new and liberalized work requirements will make about 2,500 persons age 65 and over in Cuyahoga County eligible for benefits, Mr. Boehringer estimated.

The seven major amendments are:

1. Benefits can be paid to disabled workers of any age. Severely disabled workers will no longer have to wait until they are 50 to receive disability insurance benefits.

2. Beginning next year, most beneficiaries who work will have less benefits withheld. Under the new law, a beneficiary who earns more than \$1200 in a year will have \$1 of his benefits withheld for each \$2 that he earns from \$1200 up to \$1500.

Kenyon College in 1846

First volunteer among the 340,000 Ohio men to serve in the Union forces of the Civil War was Lorin Andrews, president of Kenyon College at Gambier.

Born in a log cabin at Ashland in 1819, Andrews in Feb. 1861, believing that war was inevitable, offered his services to Gov. Dennison. In April he raised a company in Knox county and was elected Colonel of the 4th O.V.I. regiment.

Col. Andrews served in the West Virginia campaign where, owing to exposure, he was taken sick and died in Sept. 1861. He was buried at Gambier in a spot of his own selection.

3. Benefits are raised for some children. The monthly benefits of each child of a worker who has died will be three-quarters of the amount the worker would have received if he had lived and drawn retirement benefits.

4. The aged dependent widowers of women workers who died before September of 1950 may receive benefits. The widower can get benefits if the woman worker, before her death, had worked under social security for at least a year and a half. To qualify for benefits, the widower must have been dependent upon his wife for at least one-half of his support and must be 65 or older.

5. The amount of work required to get benefits has been reduced. Under the new law, many people can become insured sooner. Also, many people who did not work for the length of time required under the old law will now be eligible for payments.

6. Survivors of workers who died before 1940 may now receive benefits. For example, widows of workers who died after March 31, 1938 and before January 1, 1940 may now be eligible if their husbands had at least one and a half years of work credits before death.

7. Parents who work for sons or daughters come under social security beginning in 1961 except for work around the house. Parents who work for their children in a trade or business and who do not already have social security cards will need to apply for their numbers promptly.

The new law, Mr. Boehringer stressed, will also make a number of other changes, some making it possible for more persons to be covered by social security and some making the law fairer and easier to understand.

Seeing your own or someone else's blood is a frightening experience.

Of primary importance is retaining your composure at the time of a mishap. Be absolutely sure that you stop the bleeding and prevent infection.

lications within seconds. Do not be overly concerned if blood comes through your first dressing. Simply place another one on top of the first one.

Should the steady blood flow continue, quickly contact your doctor, or get to the nearest hospital emergency room. Stitches could be required.

At the dinner table the other day, a leg on Grandma's chair cracked. She fell on the floor and

suffered bruises to her right side. Blood vessels under her skin broke, causing immediate discoloration, rapid swelling and excruciating pain. No ribs appeared to be broken.

An ice bag was applied for pain relieving purposes, and an electric heating pad reduced swelling. Cold or hot compresses would have achieved the same results.

Such brief first aid treatment is normally adequate, and can also be used for sprains.

If pain persists, and remains severe, call your physician for an X-ray to check for broken bones.

A clear-headed, sensible approach to most cuts and bruises is all that is required.



THE FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY PROGRAM IN OHIO. The 86th Congress is now a matter of history and its accomplishments, or lack of them, will be continually discussed and analyzed for sometime. During the session I have attempted to keep you advised of various action taken by the Congress as well as other happenings in our Federal government. Since there will be no further Congressional action until January, it no doubt would be of considerable interest to examine the effect of some of the action taken in this session that affects our own State of Ohio. One such item is the Federal Aid to Highway Construction Program.

The amount of money available to Ohio this year for all highway construction will be approximately 5 per cent greater than last year; and it is, I think, reasonable to assume that the allocations made to the various counties from the State will be greater also than for last year. There are four general classes of highways that receive Federal aid: the interstate system, and what is usually described as the A.B.C. system in the State. There are 1489 miles on the interstate system authorized in Ohio consisting of two main east and west routes, two south and north routes, and a diagonal route from Cincinnati to Cleveland. These are limited access highways and the Federal government pays 90 per cent of the cost of construction. About \$121 million will be available for construction of this system this year.

The next category is what we describe as the primary system, more commonly called the "A" system. These are U. S. numbered routes and some of the more important state highways. Examples are U. S. routes 3, 23, 30, 35 and 50. There are 9,000 miles of such roads in Ohio and approximately \$13 million of Federal funds have been allocated to Ohio for next year, which must be matched by the State on a 50-50 basis.

The next category, called "B" roads, are the county highways, frequently called secondary roads, which largely serve the rural area.
