

### NOV VOJAŠKI ZA KON RAZGLAŠEN V NEMČIJI

Vsi moški od 18. do 45. leta so v smislu zakona smatrani za armadne rezerviste. Doma bodo le "na dopustu."

BERLIN, 29. nov. — Nacijska vlada je danes napravila nov zakon za popolno militariziranje nemškega ljudstva. Razglašen je novi zakon za ustvaritev izrednih vojaških rezerv in za njih vzdrževanje potom letnih vojaških vežb. Zakonu so podvrženi vsi moški med 18. in 45. let. Vzhodni Prusiji pa se bo razdelila vojaško vežbo celo za moške do 55. leta.

Glasom zakona za obvezno vojaško službo se bo vse moške omenjenim starostim, ki niso na službi pri vojakih, razdelilo v tri razrede rezervistov. Vzhodni Prusiji pa v štiri. Vsi jih bo smatralo le kot "na dopustu", v vojsko pa so vsi moški, ki niso na službi, podvrženi vojaški službi. Današnji zakon, ki je bil pod kakšnimi posebnimi razredi, ki so "na dopustu", poklicati po orožju.

Določbe novega zakona so razdeljene v nedoločene. Predpisuje, da se ima član razrednih rezervistov, razredov poklicati k vojni oziroma vojaški službi, kakor bo vojni minister, in da bo vojašnost kaznjiva pod vojnem zakonom. Nedoločeno je, ali ima skrbeti za prožnost pri vojni službi. Vojnemu ministru bo prepuščeno, da pokliče vojaške rezerviste gotovih vojakov, zlasti oficirje, k letnim vojašnim tečajem v skladu s vojnimi zakoni.

Novi zakon regulira civilni vojaški stalež poklicanih rezervistov in določa v splošnem, da vsak delodajalec dovolj pripravljen mora biti, da sprejme vojaške rezerviste nazaj na delo, kadar se vrnejo iz letnih vojaških tečajev.

**Živež prost davka?**  
Dnevni odtok ohijske države je te dni sklenil, da se vojni prodajni davek na živila in druge stvari, ki se uvažajo v državo, ne bo plačeval. Po načrtu, ki se je objavilo, pa bi sprememba v veljavo šele v januarju 1937.

Davey je včeraj izjavil, da bo prihodnje leto ponovno kandidiral, akoravno je senat Bulkeley povzročil, da je njegov kandidatstvo proti njemu. Izjavil je, da bo med ohijskimi demokraciji prihodnje leto, ko se bo izvedel predsedniški volitve, ostel notranji boj.

### ZANIMIVE VESTI IZ ŽIVLJENJA NAŠIH LJUDI PO ŠIRNI AMERIKI

Po desetletni odsotnosti se je zopet vrnil v Ameriko sloviti jugoslovanski oziroma hrvatski violinski virtuos Zlatko Baloković, ki bo imel koncert v New Yorku v Carnegie Hall 4. decembra ob 8:30 zvečer. Baloković je natančno pred desetimi leti prvič nastopil na koncertnih odrih Amerike. Od tedaj je prepotoval vso zemeljsko oblo in obdržal koncerte v najrazličnejših deželah sveta. Zadnja leta je nastopal največ po evropskih državah, zlasti na Angliškem, Francoskem, Nizozemskem, ter Nemškem in v skandinavskih deželah, pa tudi v Rusiji, na Poljskem, Češkem in v svoji domovini Jugoslaviji. On je eden izmed naših redkih naših ljudi, ki si je pridobil priznanje pred svetovno umetniško javnostjo. Baloković igra na gosli izredne kakovosti, ki so zadnja kreacija najslavnejšega izdelovalca gosli, Stradivarija, ki jih je izdeloval pred svojo smrtjo leta 1734. Te gosli so ene izmed šestorice najslavnejših na svetu in njih vrednost je bajeslovna. Rokjaki v New Yorku in okolici gotovo posejijo njegov koncert. Cena sedežev je od 83c do \$2.75. Kadar Baloković obišče druga ameriška mesta, kjer biva, na njih ljudi, bomo o tem poročali.

### Anglija zahteva pojasnilo od Japoncev

Poslanik v Tokiju hoče vedeti, kakšne namene ima Japonska v severnem Kitaju.

LONDON, 28. nov. — Angliška vlada je naročila svojemu poslaniku v Tokiju, da vpraša japonsko vlado, kakšne namene ima z ozirom na nedavne dogodke v severni Kitajski, in da jo opozori na obstoj pogodbe devetih sil, katero je podpisala tudi Japonska ter s tem jamčila teritorialno nedotakljivost Kitajske.

Angliška vlada je nastopila brez vsakega odlašanja, ko je prišla vest, da so japonski vojaki zasedli postaje ob progi severno-kitajske železnice, ki je bila zgrajena delno z angleškim kapitalom. Med lastniki bondov železnice je več Angležev in železniški dohodki se rabijo za kritje angleških posojil Kitajski.

Povpraševanje v Tokiju pa seveda ne pomeni, da Anglija namerava nastopiti vsled kršenja pogodbe devetih sil. Angleži so že večkrat prej opozorili Japonsko na to pogodbo, zlasti tekom mandžurske krize in pa za časa šanghajske epizode leta 1932, ne da bi podvzeli kako nadaljnjo akcijo.

Vendar pa opomin utegne presenetiti Japonsko vzpričo dejstva, da je omenjena pogodba tesno zvezana z washingtonskim mornariškim paktom, čigar obnovitev se ima razmisliti na predstoječi mornariški konferenci v Londonu. Japonci so sicer že večkrat izjavili, da na konferenci ne bodo pravljali političnih vprašanj, toda opomin na pogodbo devetih sil tik pred konferenco, ki se ima sniti tukaj čez dober teden dni, jih vseeno najbrže spravi v neprijetno zadrego.

Nova država, ki je bila razglašena te dni v severni Kitajski, uživa popolno podporo japonskih militaristov, ki se izgovarjajo, da so poslali vojaštvo v ozemlje, ker kitajska vlada ni sposobna kontrolirati "komunističnih banditov."

### "New Deal" še vedno izgublja tla

Drugo tedensko poročilo poizkusnega glasovanja, ki ga vodi tehnik "Literary Digest", zopet kaže, da Rooseveltova administracija izgublja tla med prebivalstvom dežele. Poizkusne glasovnice se je doslej prejelo iz dvanajstih držav in večina je še vedno proti New Dealu. Ta teden je vključena tudi država Ohio, kjer je bilo oddanih 14,868 glasov. Od teh glasov jih je za Rooseveltov program samo 5,113, proti pa 9,744. Ako je to glasovanje zanesljivo merilo, bi Roosevelt danes v Ohio dobil samo 34,46 odstotkov glasov, 65,54 odstotkov pa bi bilo oddanih proti njemu. Vseh glasov v poizkusnem glasovanju širom dvanajstih držav je doslej 207,087. Za Rooseveltov program jih je 91,351, oziroma 44,11 odstotkov, proti pa 115,736, oziroma 55,98 odstotkov.

Večina ima Roosevelt samo v državah Georgia in Texas, dočim poizkusno glasovanje kaže manjšino za New Deal v Floridi, Illinoisu, Iowi, Kansasu, Minnesoti, Missouriju, Nebraski, North Dakoti, Ohio in Oklahomi.

### Klerikalni zarotniki v Mehiki aretirani

MEXICO City. — V mehiškanski državi Jalisco je bilo te dni aretiranih dvanajst klerikalcev, ki so pripadali takozvani "levičarski" frakciji mehiških katoličanov, ki agitira za nasilno strmoglavljenje sedanje vlade. Vsi so obtoženi hujškanja proti vladi. Visoki cerkveni krogi niso glede aretacij podali nikake izjave. Vlada trdi, da so aretirani vodili kampanjo proti novemu šolskemu zakonu, ki je v zadnjem času dovedla do umora več učiteljev. V zarotniški družbi, ki je bila aretirana, sta tudi dve ženski, ki sta obtoženi, da so pomagali klerikalnim rebelom dobivati orožje in municijo. Klerikalni "levičarji" v Mehiki se ne strinjajo s taktiko škofa Diaza v Mexico Cityju, ker zagovarja stališče, da se cerkev v kampanjo za svoje zahteve ne sme posluževati nasilja. Vsled tega so levčarji škofa obdolžili "izdajstva".

### Vidmar imenovan, Antončič odslovljen

Včeraj je administracija župana Burtona imenovala za pomožnega policijskega prokuratorja slovenskega odvetnika W. A. Vidmarja, istočasno pa je bil odslovljen kot ravnatelj St. Clairskega kopalnišča Martin "Heine" Antončič. Vidmar je bil neodvisen demokratski kandidat za councilmana, ko pa je pri primarnih volitvah izgubil bitko, se je izjavil za Burtona, ki je kandidiral kot neodvisen republikanec. Antončič je prvič dobil službo kot ravnatelj kopalnišča pod administracijo managerja Morgana. Ko je bil izvoljen Miller, je bil odslovljen, pod županstvom Davisa pa je bil ponovno imenovan na staro mesto.

Odslovlitev Antončiča je vse kakor obžalovanje vredna, kajti nobenega dvoma ni, da je svojo službo vršil vestno in v korist naselbine, in da si boljšega človeka kot je on za to mesto sploh ni moglo predstavljati. ## Francija svari Mussolinija glede Anglije

Premijer Laval je uradno posvaril Italijo, da Francija ne bo držala križem rok, če bo Anglija napadena.

Italijanski upi, da se bo oljne sankcije zopet odložilo, so splavali po vodi.

LONDON, 29. nov. — Avtoritativni angleški viri so nocoj sporočili v javnost, da je francoski premijer Laval sporočil Italiji dejanski ultimatum, v katerem je posvaril Mussolinija, da Francija ne bo mogla držati križem rok, ako bi Italija izvršila napad na Veliko Britanijo. Mussolini je namreč zadnji čas dal razumeti, da ako Anglija izpolnjuje pri Ligi narodov oljne sankcije proti Italiji, se bo to smatralo za "vojno dejanje", na katero bo Italija odgovorila z napadom na angleško vojno brodovje v Sredozemskem morju.

Laval je italijanskemu poslaniku direktno rekel, da bo Francija tak napad smatrala za napad na Francijo.

Brzojavne vesti iz Pariza pravijo, da je Lavalova akcija ubila italijanske upe, da bo Liga narodov ponovno odložila akcijo za oljne sankcije proti Italiji.

Visoki krogi izražajo mnenje, da se bo oljne sankcije proti Italiji hitro izvedlo, čim se vrši seja liginega sankcijskega odbora, ki je sklicana za 12. decembra.

Kot se poroča, je francoski premijer sporočil Italiji svoje

stališče po razgovoru z angleškim poslanikom George Russell Clerkem.

### ženske in otroci ubiti v zračnem napadu

ADDIS ABABA, 29. nov. — Abesinska vlada poroča, da je bilo v zrakoplovnem napadu, ki so ga Italijani vprizorili na trdnjavo mesto Daggah Bur na južni fronti ubitih tudi mnogo žensk in otrok.

"Devet italijanskih areoplanov je vrglo 1,500 bomb," se glasi poročilo abesinske vlade. Ogenj, ki je sledil, je razdejal neko novo cerkev in mnogo hiš.

Cesar Haile Selasie, ki potuje s karavano, ima nocoj dopusti v Desye. Tam bo prevzel osebno poveljstvo abesinskih čet. Cesarja spremlja več sto vojakov in pobočnikov. Karavana šteje 500 tovornih in osebnih avtomobilov. Sinoči se je ustavila v Debra Birham, potem ko je nemški avijatik Weber napravil inspekcijski polet nad pokrajino.

V cesarjevi družbi je Tecla Hawariat, ki je bil zastopnik Abesinije pri Ligi narodov, in šest belgijskih častnikov.

### Roosevelt je udaril po kritikih

ATLANTA, 29. nov. — Predsednik Roosevelt je imel danes tukaj pred 50 tisoč oseb broječo množico govor, v katerem je udaril po svojih kritikih, ki kritizirajo njegovo administracijo, zadi velikih relifnih izdatkov, češ, da s tem tira deželo v finančni polom. Predsednik je izjavil, da je najhujša depresija preštna in da se bodo tudi relifni stroški odlej naprej nižali, vsled česar je prepričan, da bo vladni deficit stalno manjši in da ne bodo potrebni nobeni novi davki.

Predsednik je to pot prvič očitno pokazal, da mu gre kritika opozicije, ki se z vsemi silami pripravlja na predsedniške volitve, kolikor toliko pod kožo.

"Kredit naše vlade stoji danes višje kot katere vlade na svetu," je dejal predsednik, "in to navzlic vsem napadom, ki jih vprizorjajo na ta kredit oni maloštevilni posamezniki in organizacije, ki skušajo diktirati administraciji in kongresu, kako naj se upravlja narodno blagajno in pusti bedne, da stradajo."
