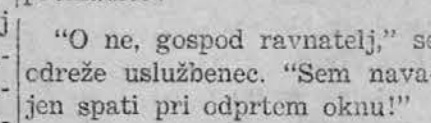

Sam pa, dokler sem živ, se ne morem posvetiti temu delu. To delo je sveto delo, in človek, ki si ga naloži, mora biti čist do dna svoje duše. In jaz nisem čist! Gospoda — prijatelja, zaupati vama hočem svojo skrivnost, in naj bo pokopana med nami: ob uri, ki nas postavi na arnautskim lupežem nasproti, ne bom vedel, ali je vaš Ali Kemal večji grešnik ... večji zločinec od mene!"

Trepet je prešinil prijatelja, ko sta slišala te turobne besede. Mr. Brown pa je nadaljeval: "Sedimo ... Evo, semkaj: za tem debelim deblom smo popolnoma v temi. Nič ne nas ne more zapaziti, mi pa vidimo vsakogar, kdor se približa po cesti ... Potipajta — tu je skala ... prostopora je za nas vse tri. Poslušajte torej zgodbo mojega greha."

Premolknil je in se ni oglasil par minut, kakor da zbira spomine in besede.

Vse na okrog je plavala tišina; le tu in tam je začelo drevje v ostrem dihu vetra.

Iz dalje ... dalje dalje ... je prihajal sunkoma šum: bili so poslednji odmevi podnevnega hrupa v Skoplju, ki se je izročalo nočnemu pokoj.

Zdajci pa je izpregovoril Amerikanec z zamolklim glasom: "Prijatelj! Zlodej, ki mi ga dajeta vest, ni naveden zločinstvo, ni premoženje, ni greh; greh je, kakor ga napravi človek v nerazumni minuti, ko umolkne pamet in zavest dolžnosti — zato pa je tem huji in neodpustnejši, tem nizkotnejši in grji. Če pomislim, da je na moji duši zapisa krasnega in cvetočega življenja — življenja, ki bi bilo lahko stajalo srečo in solnce v srca tolikih ljudi — potem, gospoda, se čudim samemu sebi in se vprašujem, ali je strahopetnost ali drzen pogum, da se nisem zadržal za samokres in izbrisal iz svojih možganov te ostudne zavesti. Bilo je pred nekaj leti: ali sta slišali zgodbo parnika "Pennsylvania"?

Jaz — takrat se srečam, s seboj in svetom zanjo mlad človek — sem bil pesnik in ladija na njeni katastrofalni vožnji. Z mano vred je bilo na poti iz Havra v New York mnogo odličnega sveta, med drugim stara dama z Angleškega v spremstvu prelestne deklice. Bili sta iz najvišje aristokracije; toliko žlahtnosti in lepote, kakor v mladi grofici Elizabeti, nisem videl združene v nobenem ženskem bitju. Nepremagljiva sila me je vlekla k njej že od prvega trenutka; približal sem se dami z vso spoštljivostjo, in zdi se, da ne zaman, par pogledov, pritisk roke — so mi razodela nekega večera, ki bi bil moral biti predzadnji naše vo-

nje, da navdajajo tudi njo napram meni nečnejša čustva, nego so navadna med tujimi srci. Tisto noč pa — legel sem bil pravkar k počitku v svoji kabini, vso dušo polno sladkih sanj o njenem ljubljenem obličju — se je pripetila strašna katastrofa. "Pennsylvania" je zadela ob ledeno goro; ladija, na kateri je vladalo uro prej še zgolj veselje in brezskrbnost, je bila v trenutku razklana skoraj na dvoje, podobna grobnici krsti, ki je vlečena na stotine življenj s seboj v svoj neizmerno globoki grob. Moja prva misel je bila v tem trenutku groze in zmede: Kje je ona?

Hotel sem jo rešiti ali poginiti z njo, objeti jo vsaj na svojo smrtno uro ... Zaman! Grofica Elizabeta in njene spremnice ni bilo nikjer, ne v njej, kabini, ne na krovu; sam Bog ve to, kako smo se izgredili v tišini zmešnjavi in obupni borbi za rešilne čolne. In že je drlo valovje preko krova; ni mi preostalo drugega, planil sem v vodo. Potegnilo me je Bog ve kako globoko, ali čudež je hotel, da sem prišel zopet na vrh. Rešilni čoln ni bil daleč odondot; par splavov, ki so jih bili napravili mornarji v naglici, se je borilo z valovi. In po vodi — strašen pogled! Na stotine ljudi je kričalo, tulilo in prosilo v tisti mesečni oceaniki noči, iztezalo roke, objemalo se drug drugega in se borilo s srditim obupom za rešilne pasove. In morje je bilo nemirno; nemogoče je bilo, rešiti le desetino ponesrečencev ...

Jaz sam sem se čutil že onemoglega; obup nad gotovo smrtjo moje oboževanke mi je bil zategnil um. Toda živalska strast do življenja ne pojenja v takih trenutkih; ona raste in nadvlada vsa druga čustva ... Right Am I not, Angy?

Has your lodge decided how the Juvenile assessment refund for the month of October, will be used? Don't you agree that a nice XMAS PARTY would hit the spot quite right? Sure the youngsters would appreciate that very, very much. Of course, it could be used for the following month's remittance on the Home Office, but the impression that would leave on the young people's minds would be practically null. And besides, a nice XMAS PARTY would be a source of valuable advertisement, not only to the Vrtecs, but to the Organization as well. And think of the happiness and delight connected with an affair of this kind. Making the little boys and girls happy gives the older folks a real sense of pleasure and joy, too.

It has come to my notice that several of our ACTIVE VRTECS are under the supervision of members well up in the years. It is my belief that our juniors should be led by young people who naturally are, or should be, better acquainted with ideas and plans which appeal to the younger element. It would be a wise policy for every senior lodge, having an active Vrtec, to pick an advisory committee from among the older people whose duty it would be to attend the juvenile meetings and offer advice on how they could be improved. Our senior members must not get it into their heads that because their Vrtec has become active that it no longer needs the benefits of their years of experience. Just because a Vrtec has become active and has a wide-awake administrator, or administratrix, as a leader, is no reason for anyone to think that a complete divorce has taken place. Parents of our Vrtec members should see that their children attend every regular meeting and attend as many of them, as possible, themselves.

Ranking among the most important local SSPZ officers are the administrators or administratrix of our Vrtecs. They are the builders of the fraternal system of tomorrow; upon them rests the future of the SSPZ. If our Society is to be great in years from now, or twenty years from now, it will be because of the effort they will have expended in the meantime.

The leaders of our youngsters must be, above everything else, conscientious. They must believe in fraternalism before they can instill that feeling into the minds and hearts of their youthful charges. They must have vision and courage. tion are able to sit and enjoy the finest music and entertainment, provided by such famous broadcasting orchestras as Guy

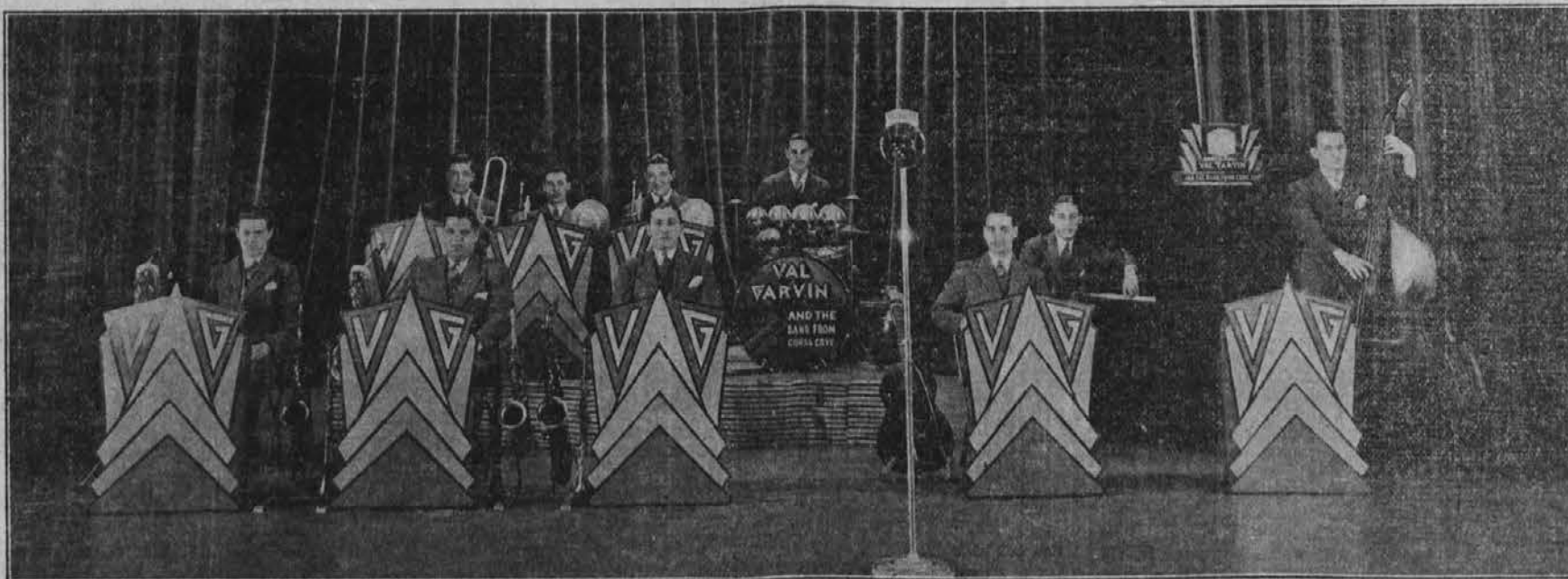
Lombardo, Val Garvin, Wayne King, etc.
