## Afrika ima svojo malo "vietnamsko" krizo

Predsednik Čadske republike, katoličan, se je zapletel v boj z muslimani, ki tvorijo večino prebivalstva republike.

CLEVELAND, O. — Afriška republika Čad je sicer dvakrat večja od Francije, toda leži tako skrita sredi Afrike, da svet komaj ve za njo. Leži ravno sredi Afrike in je obenem tudi križišče vseh prometnih žil po Afriki. Zato ni čudno, da je čadski "narod" prava mešanica plemen, ras, ver in pripadnikov večjih narodov. Vseeno se je pa francoski kolonialni upravi posrečilo, da je iz kolonije, odnosno sedanja republike napravila vsaj neke vrste kulturno skupnost, o narodni edinstvi seveda ne more biti niti govora.

Kot vse francoske kolonije, ima tudi Čad precej prebivalcev, ki so pripadniki katoliške Cerkve. Med njimi je tudi sedanji vladni predsednik Tombalbaye. V svojem življenju je začel z učiteljskim poklicem, potem pa je postal unijski uradnik, kar mu je dalo priliko, da je ustanoval svojo stranko in preko nje prilezel na vodilno mesto v republiki. Ima pa tudi dosti tekmecev in nasprotnikov, ki niso katoličani, ampak večina muslimani.

Te je dal poloviti in pozapreti, ne zato ker so muslimanske vere, ampak radi tega, ker so baje nameravali s silo strmoljaliti sedanje vlado. Kot v Vietnamu so političen spor pretekel na versk podlagu. Za zadevo se zanima sam De Gaulle, ne morda radi politike sedanja vlade, ampak radi tega, ker je blizu čadske prestolice Fort Lamy, največje afriško letališče, ki ga Francija uporablja kot križišče v svojih letalskih zvezah z Afriko. V Čadu se za krizo ne zanima nihče razen politik v prestolici. Milijon novadov, ki živi v tej republiki, ima druge posle in brige.

**Dr. Adenauer dobil tako vafitansko odlikovanje kot nikdaj Bismarck**

RIM, It. — Nemški kancler Adenauer je začel delati zadnje obiske na svoji dolgi politični poti. Sel je najprvo v Rim, kjer ga je sv. oče sprejel v nenavadno dolgi zaseben avdijenc. Najbrže je hotel papež zvedeti kar iz kancelerjevih ust, kakšna je lahko politična bodočnost sedajne Zahodne Nemčije.

Kot je navada, je dr. Adenauer dobil pri tej priliki tudi cerkveno odlikovanje. Doživel je izredno čast, da je dobil najvišji red, ki ga tuji državni poglavari dobijo samo v izjemnih slučajih: Red sv. Srca Jezusovega. Po čudnem naključju je bil znani nemški kanceler Bismarck tisti, ki je zadnji pred Adenaurom dobil podobno odlikovanje. Skoraj sto let je poteklo, da je bil Nemec deželen zopet take časti.

## Za ustanovitev civilnih pravic ne kaže dobro!

WASHINGTON, D.C. — V predstavnškem domu imajo podporniki načrta za novo ustanovitev civilnih pravic dovolj glasov, da ga odobre v plenumu, kadar bo pač prišel tja, ko bo končal svojo pot skozi odvore. Kdaj bo to, je še vedno odprto vprašanje.

V Senatu je položaj drugačen. Tam utegne na kak način predlog še premagati ovire v posameznih odborih, čeprav bo do številne in hude, toda njegojo do prepricaanja, da so Rusi v zadnjem času opremili svoje plenume nimajo absolutne večine, ki bi mu mogla zagotoviti anih vrste "Echo" z raketa, ki lahko ponese skupno do 25 do glasovanja. Tega bodo južni megatonov atomskih bomb do demokrati, kot že dolgo napovedujejo, skušali preprečiti z Vsaka od te vrste ruskih neprekjenih debato. Spremenil je torej svoje stališče, kar pomeni za naše strokovnjake malo presenečenje. Ne morejo si razlagati, zakaj je do tega prišlo, dasiravno jim je že pred tedni namignil angleški strokovnjak Lowell, da se utegne kaj takega zgodi. To je povdel, ko se je ravno vrnil iz Moskve.

Morda so tudi Rusi izračunali, da je izlet na Luno izredno draga stvar. Ako se Amerika boji stroškov, zakaj se jih ne bi tudi Rusija? Lahko je pa tudi mogoče, da so Rusi pri svojih pripravah naleteli na tehnične ovire, ki jih ne morejo premagati. Znano pa je, da so člani ruske akademije znanosti različnega mnenja, eni zagovarjajo načrt, drugi so proti njemu.

Tudi med našimi strokovnjaki ni edinstvo, kaj naj bo z izletom na Luno. Seveda niso tudi istih misli o koristi sodelovanja z Rusi. Zadevo bo najbrže moral odločiti sam predsednik Kennedy.

Blizu polovice ljudi je mesto zapustilo, drugi pa žive v šotorih in preostalih hišah ter skušajo mesto obnoviti. Po zadnjih cenevitah bodo verjetno mogli rešiti do ene četrte vseh stanovanj, med tem ko so še pred nekaj tedni trdili, da bo treba porušiti vse razen kakih 10 odstotkov.

Pomoč ponesrečencem prihaja še vedno z vseh strani. Ameriška vojaška poljska bolnišnica, ki je prva prihabela na kraj nesreče že tretji dan po potresu, je pretekli teden obzahvali prebivalstva in oblasti zapustila Jugoslavijo, ko je tam svoje delo opravila.

## Otrok je trmast, jezikav, grob, samosvoj

Dogodi se večkrat, da mati tarna in toži o svojem otroku, čeprav je v šoli odličnjak, prijazen, vlijeden, se odlično razume s sošolci in ga tudi učitelj hvali. Mati pa pravi, da je do mat zadirčen, jezikav, uporen in samosvoj, se skratka grdo obnaša s starši in dedoma. Babica se zaradi tega večkrat joče, dedek pa se jezi in krega. Mati skuša otroka poučiti, a uspeh je vedno enak: otrok je grob, nepotrežljiv, neznen, izven doma pa se vedno dobro obnaša. Kako si to razlagamo?

Napaka je v vzgoji. Kljubovalnost ni otroku prizavljena, ampak jo je pridobil med vzgojo in je njen posledica. Kljubovalnost preide pologoma tudi v grobost, ki pa je večkrat le znak otrokove obrameb pred vzgojnimi vplivi, s katerimi se ni mogel spriznati. Značilno je pri tem, da se otrok tako obnaša samo doma. Če je edinec, je v družini gotovo imel vse skozi izjemni položaj in se njen dobro dobitje razvije.

Zaradi pretirane pozornosti in skrbi se njegova osebnost ni prav nič razvijala in se zato sedaj upira. V odnosih z otrokom se starši uveljavljati samo kot gospodarji in ne kot starejši prijatelji in voditelji, kar bi moral veljati pri vseki drobni in tudi brezpomembni stvari. 

PARIZ, Fr. — Zunanji minister Zahodne Nemčije G. Schröder je bil ta teden tu na razgovorih s francoskim zunanjim ministrom Mauriceom Couve de Murville. Jedro razgovorov je bilo posvečeno vprašanju nade,

že leta 1943 je pokojni škof ljevanja pogajan med Združenim Rožman v pastirskem pismu nimi državami in Sovjetsko napisal tolažilne besede: "Pal- zvezo o zmanjšanju mednarodne mučenštva so zrastle tudi ne napetosti v svetu, posebno na naših tleh, naša domača v Evropi.

Nemški in francoski zunanjii krvjo naših bratov in sestra, ki ste jih poznali, z njimi delali, z vlad sporazumela, da njuni vladni vicer, hodili, z njimi di ne bosta priznali sovjetskih osvojitev v drugi svetovni vojni in po njej v Srednji in Vzhodni Evropi. Razgovori med Francijo in Nemčijo o tem vprašanju se bodo nadaljevali, ko bo prihodnji mesec prevzel vodstvo nemške vlade sedanji podkancler in gospodarski minister dr. Erhard.

Leta 1950 je škof Rožman izročil sv. očetu Piju XII. v nemščini pisan življenjepis mladca Lojzeta Grozdetja, ki so ga komunisti kruto mučili in umorili. Ko je sv. oče knjiga prebral, je naročil slovenskemu duhovniku, ki je odhajal v Slovenijo na obisk, naj bi v Ljubljani takoj začeli zasljevati priče. "Če s pričami dokazete, da je vse to res, Lojzeta Grozdetja takoj proglašim za mučenca in za blaženega." Isto velja tudi za turjaške junake, in za vrnjene ter pobite domobrance. Če rečem borcev, ni nujno, da mislim vojaka z orožjem v roki. Saj smo vendor po sv. birmi vsi vojščaki Kristusovi. Da bi se le res vedno zavedali te svoje odlike!

Za narod je trenutni poraz večkrat velika pridobitev. Spomnimo se špartanskih junakov, ki so do zadnjega vsi padli braneč termopolski prelaz in, kako se je ob njihovem zaledju grška mladina navduševala za spolnjevanje dolžnosti.

Take narodne tragedije so hvalježna snov pisateljem in pesnikom, katere navdušujejo, da ustvarjajo leposlovne biserje, ki narod navdušujejo za verske in narodne ideale. Naj samo omenim srbsko Kosovo. Zeleti bi bilo, da bi slovenski pisatelji in pesniki čim bolj segali po tej snovi in opisovali naše vzvišene vzornike in prekrasne zglede mučenštva", ne kakor delamo mi, ki bi radi dognali, zakaj nismo turjaške tragedije preprečili, marveč kažejo nujnega idealizem in zvestobo ter stanovitost v veri.

Zapisal sem, da je na Turjaku mladostni idealizem prevabil vojaško znanje. Z zgolj človeškega stališča je bilo to napak. Če pa z božjo lučjo posvetim v dogodek pred 20 leti, moram reči: Zahvaljen bodi Bog za ta idealizem, ki je slovenskemu narodu ustvaril toliko mučencev!

Naj bo njihov zaled kot mogičen plamen, ki bo nas in zanamce navduševal, da se ne odturnimo vzvišenim vzorom, za katere so oni dali življenje, marveč da smo jih pripravljeni braniti tudi z žrtvami!


### "MEDICAL HUMANETICS"

The new science of electronics is a complex mystery to most of us. But we do know that it is a performer of miracles. All manner of tasks are performed with incredible speed and accuracy, and human minds and hands are freed for other and more rewarding duties.

Now electronics is reaching into medicine, "Medical humanetics" is the descriptive term given to a dramatic new approach to research, treatment and management of long-term illness and injury. It combines highly sensitive modern instrumentation and data processing equipment to maintain fast and frequent checks on patients, singly and in groups, and to produce a new kind of quickly retrievable health record.

Involved, according to Dr. William A. Spencer, Director of the Texas Institute for Rehabilitation and Research, are "...the first steps toward the medicine of the future." The physician of today must deal with a rising sea of data, all needed to define the nature of an illness and to prescribe for it. Now, Dr. Spencer goes on, "...by using electronic aids — collecting millions of tiny pieces of data about a patient at his bedside, then feeding them into a computer — we are speeding up and increasing the flow of information between the doctor and the patient. We are coming up with more accurate clues — and some we didn't even suspect. This means that the patient gets better treatment because it is ultra-precise and individualized."

No machine, no matter how efficient, will ever take the place of the doctor. In medicine, as in so many other crafts and professions, human skill, human knowledge and experience, human understanding will always be the basic essentials. But in this new electronic age, science is giving us enormously effective tools with which to deal with a multitude of problems and needs. And we are only at the beginning.

## Reporting from Washington

**SEPTEMBER SLOWDOWN.** With no business scheduled last week and very little this week, the House is facing a September slowdown apparently because the Majority Leadership feels the time is not yet ripe for slowdowns on a score of important measures already approved by Committees. Since the 88th Congress began last January, the bulk of the activity has been in the Committees, which as far back as April began turning out major bills for House consideration. The fact that the House has not yet considered many of these Committee-recommended bills and probably will not do so in the near future is attributed to these main factors: (1) Practical certainty that some would be defeated if put to a roll call in the House at this time. (2) Congressional leadership strategy to delay action on several until the House passes the tax bill and civil rights legislation. (3) Reluctance of the House Rules Committee to clear some of these bills.

Typical of the bills which the Majority Leadership are hesitant about calling up for fear of being defeated is an Administration bill authorizing \$190 million to help build civil defense fall-out shelters. Bills approved by various Committees and awaiting Rules Committee clearance include those for creation of a Youth Conservation Corps, a mass transit program, a cotton price supports measure, a one-year extension of Federal aid to schools in communities affected by large Federal installations, a Fair Employment Opportunities Act, a "quality stabilization" bill permitting manufacturers of brand-name products to set minimum prices, additional funds for the area redevelopment program, and another Mexican Farm labor bill. The latter two were defeated earlier this year in the House, but both have been approved by the Senate in slightly different forms and now they are back with us.

Another reason for the slowdown is the fact that the Senate is far behind the House in its consideration of bills. Among the important House-passed measures now in Senate Committees are the bills calling for Federal aid to higher education

### CLEVELAND FIRMS SHARE FOREIGN AID ORDERS

Foreign aid orders totaling \$401,312 are being filled by Cleveland manufacturers, according to the Agency for International Development, the State Department Agency which administers the program. Provisions in loan and development agreements limit procurement from sources outside the United States and thus keep more than three-fourths of AID-financed commodity expenditures within the U.S. economy. The Lincoln Electric Company received the largest single order in the Cleveland area. Working under a subcontract received from another U.S. firm, Lincoln Electric is supplying \$78,600 worth of equipment for a company in Turkey. Jones and Laughlin Steel Corp. is producing several orders of steel products for purchasers in India and Pakistan. Its total of \$78,062 in orders came from two New York exporters who hold contracts from the overseas buyers.

A manufacturer in India has ordered \$63,152 worth of steel products being produced at Republic Steel's Cleveland plant. U.S. Steel has also received orders for \$47,058 worth of steel from India and Pakistan. Pig iron valued at \$44,699 for a firm in Pakistan is being produced at the Cleveland plant of Pickands Mather and Co. Ryan Industries is manufacturing \$43,919 worth of liquid oxygen and related equipment for a company in Calcutta. Other Cleveland area orders include the following: Avtron Manufacturing Co., \$14,797 worth of aviation equipment for the Ethiopian government; Thompson Ramo Woodbridge, Inc., \$8,784 for spare parts for agricultural equipment destined for use in Turkey; and Brush Instruments, \$3,745 for supplies for a Spanish school.

## Use of Synthetic Shoe Materials Causes Skin Ailments, British Study Finds

The findings of a British scientific report that an increase in the use of substitutes for leather in shoes has been paralleled by a corresponding rise in skin ailments of the feet were termed "disquieting" by a leading American foot specialist.

The Report, by Dr. Frank Charlesworth of Manchester, England, termed "remarkable" the "marked increase" in warts and athlete's foot among 5,500 English schoolchildren following the introduction of synthetic materials and plastics in the manufacture of footwear. Dr. Charlesworth's report was published in the Journal of the American Podiatry Association.

Dr. Benjamin Kauth, director of the American Foot Care Institute and a prominent podiatrist, noted that the report from England bore out the findings of earlier American studies of foot diseases among school-age youngsters and reports from practicing podiatrists in many areas of the U.S.

"What is most disturbing about this development," — Dr. Kauth stressed, — "is news that more substitute materials are about to be introduced in this country." The





The basic breakfast is defined as one which provides one-fourth the total daily caloric requirement, and one-fourth the total daily protein allowance. During the experiment involving school boys, while the total daily food allowances were rigidly controlled and the boys were in school, the teacher in charge of the group made careful observations and records of the attitudes and scholastic attainments of the boys. The report showed that the majority of the boys had a definitely better attitude and a better scholastic record during the period when breakfast was included in the daily dietary regimen than when it was omitted. A basic cereal and milk breakfast pattern—fruit juice, cereal, milk, bread and butter or margarine, will be a material asset to your school-age boys and girls in the matter of attitude and scholastic attainment. ## GETTING THE MOST... FROM YOUR GARDEN

### THE LAWN IN FALL: RECOVERY AND REFITTING

After the long days of glare and heat in summer, the lawn is likely to be showing signs of wear and tear. While this is true of well-established turf, it is still more true of lawns made last fall or in spring, which will now be exhibiting any defects of construction, flaws in the soil or imperfections in the seeding. This is the best time for renovation and repairs, while the grasses can yet make weeks of growth before going into winter dormancy.



All plants need food, lawn grasses more in proportion than most others because their leaf blades are always being mowed off as soon as they make much growth, even to the extent, if it was all added up, of 30 or 40 inches in a season. In this way the nitrogen, the great leaf-maker, which the roots get from the soil, is continually being used up and carried away, together with smaller amounts of other essential food elements. Of all these elements, nitrogen is not only the most wanted but it is also the one that is most easily washed out of the soil by rain. Until recently this has meant rather a troublesome condition in lawn care, with the grass too often in a state of feast or famine. But with 30 or 40 million lawns in the country as a result of the building boom, scientists have been at work on this matter and have developed slow-release, long-lasting nitrogen compounds to encourage the steady, even growth that makes a good lawn.

It is prescribed by law that on every bag of fertilizer three figures must be printed, showing the proportion it contains of the principal food elements — nitrogen, phosphorus and potash. In fertilizer blended for lawns, these figures will perhaps be 22-8-4, denoting a 22% content of nitrogen. A fraction of this will be inorganic and will go into solution quickly, but the major portion will be of the new organic material which can be used to provide a winter mulch for flower beds, or added to the compost heap.

One final, and easy, aid to the lawn this year is what is known as dormant seeding. Any time between Thanksgiving and Christmas, scatter good seed at the rate of two pounds to 1,000 sq. feet and let it lie there to be settled in through the winter by natural means. This may gain as much as a month in client, least messy, way to secure renovation next spring.

### Have Your Feet Had Their 1,000 Mile Check-Up?

The first step to good foot starts with the shoes you wear. Summer-time sport in flimsy playshoes can leave your feet in dire need of toning up. To avoid fall foot aches, foot specialists recommend that your shoes be made of leather. Because of its resiliency, leather in the upper part of the shoe makes your feet feel free while still giving plenty of support. And in addition to being light on your feet, leather soles absorb the pounding your feet take from all that mileage you cover each day.




