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## JEZUS, POT, KI VODI K OČETU

Besede današnjega evangelija je Jezus namenil svojim učencem v dvorani zadnje večerje tik pred trpljenjem. Jezus je pred svojim trpljenjem hotel svoje učence pripraviti na začasno bolečo ločitev od njega, ki jo bo prinesel s seboj ta dogodek. Jezus jih hoče razvedriti in jim dati gotovost. Cilj njegovega odhoda je, da jim pripravi prostor v Očetovi hiši. V bistvu pojasnjuje njim in po njih vsem svojim bodočim učencem globok smisel svojega trpljenja in čudovite sadove, ki bodo sledili.

Jezus je prišel na svet, da bi nas pripeljal v Očetovo hišo, v polno občestvo z njim. A da bi to dosegel, je bilo potrebno, da je trpel in umrl. Zato je Jezus lahko rekel: »Nihče ne pride k Očetu drugače kot po meni«.

Jezus je vedno v Očetovi hiši, zato stopiti v edinstvo z Jezusom pomeni biti v polnem občestvu z Očetom, vstopiti v Očetovo hišo.

Kakšna pa je konkretna pot, da bi stopili v edinstvo z Jezusom? Ta pot je živeti njegovo besedo in njegove zapovedi. Bolj ko bomo učenci živeli Jezusovo besedo, bolj bomo vstopali v tesno občestvo z njim in se bomo zavedali, da sta Jezus in Oče eno, da je Oče v Jezusu in Jezus v Očetu.

V moči vere in milosti imamo že sedaj določeno izkustvo te tesne povezanosti z Jezusom in Očetom; vendar se bo še povečala preko darov luči in ljubezni, ki jih bo Sveti Duh izvršil v nas. Z očmi vere bomo vedno bolj videli, da nam v Jezusu govori Oče in da nas v Jezusu ljubi Oče in nas priteguje k sebi.

Obstaja pa še dodatno izkustvo: to so sadovi, ki jih bo uresničil učenec, ki bo združen z Jezusom. Če lahko tako rečemo, bo izvršil še večja dela, kot jih je izvršil Jezus: »Kdor veruje vame, bo dela, ki sem jih jaz opravljal, tudi sam opravljal in še večja kot ta bo opravljal« (Jn 14,12). Gre za sadove krščanskega življenja, ki jih Sveti Duh rodi po učencu, to se pravi po skupnost, ki jo on rodi in začne.

Če sedaj med toliko spodbudami preidemo nase, se bomo omejili samo na eno: na model Cerkev, ki se pokaže iz teh Jezusovih besed.

## 5<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER

To je Cerkev v najglobljem pomenu, v skrivnosti, to se pravi, v vezi edinosti, ki povezuje in zliva skupaj vse člane, ki jo sestavljajo: edinosti z Jezusom in edinosti med sabo. To je Cerkev kot družina. Kot skupnost bratov, katere življenje je že sedaj soudeležba, čeprav z vsemi omejitvami našega zemeljskega stanja, pri razmerju med tremi Božjimi osebami.

V zvezi s tem nam lahko pomagajo tudi besede apostola Petra v drugem berilu. Ne po naključju, apostol krščansko skupnost primerja z zgradbo, zgrajeno iz živih kamnov, ki je utemeljena na vogelnem kamnu, Kristusu. Sklicuje se na kristjane, ki so v veri in ljubezni trdno povezani s Kristusom in med seboj. Govori o skupnosti, ki je obdarovana z določeno trdnostjo, stabilnostjo in nezadržno močjo širjenja prav zaradi tega, ker je utemeljena na edinosti, ki jo je hotel Jezus.

Jasno je, da v tovrstni krščanski skupnosti ne more biti prostora za individualizem, to se pravi, da bi krščansko vero vsak hotel živeti po svoje. To bi bila nesmiselna zahteva, ker bi bila popolnoma nasprotna sami naravi Cerkve.

S tem pa je jasen tudi poziv, ki nam ga daje današnji evangelij. Gre za prizadevanje, da bi med seboj utrjevali edinstvo, da bi izboljšali svoj odnos z Jezusom in z brati, za kar moramo izkoristiti vse različne priložnosti, ki nam jih življenje ponuja vsak dan. Narediti torej tako, da bodo vsi naši odnosi živi, kakor jih hoče Jezus; v njegovi resnici, v njegovem nauku in v njegovi ljubezni.

Kako ne bi pri tem pomislili na tisti zakrament, ki je središče in vir vsega življenja edinosti Cerkve, na evharistijo? Zelo razširjena miselnost teži za tem, da bi evharistično obhajilo omejila na zasebno razmerje med posameznikom in Jezusom. Vera pa nas spodbuja, da bi vedno bolj doumeli povabilo, ki prihaja k nam od Jezusa - evharistije, naj gremo k bratom, k skupnosti. Kot prvo stvar v evharistiji Jezus hoče narediti iz nas utrjevalce edinosti na različnih področjih, kjer koli že smo. To je pogoj, da pridemo do vedno globljega in vedno bolj rodovitnega odnosa z Jezusom.

## Illustration

Some of you may have seen the recent film (2023) of Rachel Joyce's book, *The Unlikely Pilgrimage of Harold Fry*, starring Jim Broadbent and Penelope Wilton. But a less well-known book by the same author could bring us some insights into life as a community.

In *The Music Shop*, Joyce explores how local characters become real neighbours. They live in a run-down area, where there are lots of quirky and interesting characters. It's the story of Frank, a music shop owner, who will only sell vinyl records. But it's the way he listens that makes him special.

“Frank could not play music, he could not read a score, he had no practical knowledge whatsoever, but when he sat in front of a customer and truly listened, he heard a kind of song.”

Each customer is different, each has their own story, and they are amazed that he always works out what kind of music is for them.

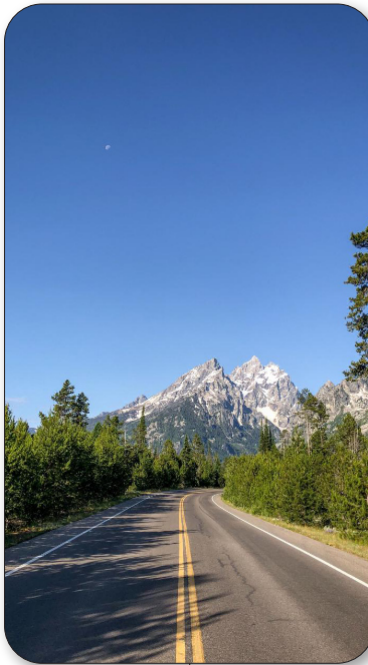
### Gospel teaching

Shortly before his death on the cross, Jesus speaks to his disciples. They are worried and afraid. He has already told them that he will be betrayed and denied. He has let them know that he will only be with them for a little while longer (John 13).

They haven't really understood, but he knows they are wondering what is happening. He wants to reassure them. “*Do not let your hearts be troubled,*” he says. But they are struggling to understand. Philip is still looking for a clearer sign, a visible sign. Thomas is not sure how to follow when he does not know where Jesus is going.

These are very human worries, similar to concerns we might have ourselves. Jesus tells them to have faith in him. He invites them to trust in him. He will give them the strength and courage to face all their difficulties. He lets them know that “in my Father's house there are many dwelling places,” and there will be a place for them. In the end they will be where he is.

“How can we know the way?” Thomas asks. Jesus explains that he is the way. His way is the way of love. Shortly after this, he tells them again that to love him is to keep his commandments (John 14:15). Love of God and love of neighbour are the heart of his teaching.



### Application

We might find it hard to trust and to hope. Perhaps our experiences in life have left us feeling that everything is risky, and that we can't count on others. Perhaps we are wary of taking an action, in case we get it wrong.

But Jesus tells us to have faith, to take the risk of trusting in him. He will take care of us. He will give us the courage and strength to go on. His words are gentle and full of love. He can see that his disciples are struggling. He finds ways to let them know they are loved.

When we look around us today, we can see a lot of hatred and division. We can see anger. We hear, just like we heard in the first reading, that some people are getting to the front of the queue quicker than we are.

Social media in particular delights in stirring up controversy, often by spreading rumours and untruths. It's easy to get carried along in a wave of disinformation. Do we even know who our neighbours really are? Are we contributing to our local community, building people up, or are we busy knocking them down?

Jesus is the Way. Not in a narrow sense, which excludes, but in a generous, abundant sense, which holds us all together. His way is Life – life in all its fullness.

To embrace his way is to love each other as neighbours, as brothers and sisters. This is his commandment, to love one another as he loves us.

## OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS CEMETERY

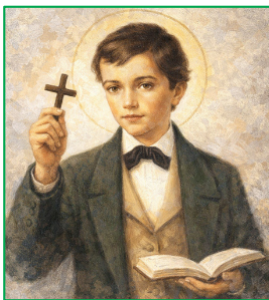

## DOMINIC SAVIO - FEAST ON MAY 6

St. Dominic Savio was an inspirational boy who died as a teenager and became a canonized saint. There are not too many teenage saints in the Church's list of saints – especially non-martyred ones. Dominic is only one of three or four.



Dominic not only made the cut because St. John Bosco promoted his star pupil in a written biography, but because he really was outstanding in virtue.

Dominic lived in the 1800's and went to Don Bosco's Oratory. He was the 'original Carlo Acutis' – a sincerely spiritual and joyful kid. Beaming with the radiance of goodness, he made his peers aspire to be better men and better Christians. Let me tell you his story.

In Northern Italy, a short distance from where Don Bosco was born, there was a village called San Giovanni di Riva. Dominic Savio was born there on April 2, 1842. He was the second of eleven children to Carlo and Brigida Savio. They were poor, hardworking and pious people. Carlo was a blacksmith.

Dominic was very bright, did his chores, helped his parents raise his siblings and enjoyed learning at the one-room schoolhouse in the village. The Savio family were pious but it was obvious to all that Dominic had a sincere love for Christ and the Blessed Mother. He prayed the rosary on his own, went to early morning Mass and made visits to the Blessed Sacrament whenever he went into town. Dominic was prudent in his speech, and temperate and balanced with work, study and prayer. He had remarkable control over his emotions, and while he could get angry like boys do, he was able to control himself in most situations. He was friendly and did his chores, duties without fuss.

While children of the time customarily received their First Communion in their early teens, the village priest recognized Dominic's remarkable piety and let him make his First Communion at the age of seven. On the day of his First Communion Dominic wrote down four resolutions:

1. I will go to Confession and Communion as often as my confessor will allow.
2. I will sanctify Sundays and holy days in a special way.
3. Jesus and Mary will be my friends.
4. Death, but not sin.

Believe it or not, Dominic had the discipline to live these resolutions. He wanted to grow in holiness. He even wanted to be a priest one day. He knew education was necessary for his formation. Imagine a boy of ten trudging a total of six miles to and from school every day for two years. That's what Dominic Savio did, because the school was three miles away. On a very hot day an elderly man met him and asked, "Aren't you tired of walking so far alone on this country road day after day?" "I'm not alone," replied Dominic. "I have my guardian angel with me."

To top it off, Dominic was not the biggest kid. He was a bit of a skinny runt. Overall, his health was less than average but his spirit was strong. One day at the school the priest in charge of the boys reprimanded the class messing up the woodstove and smoking out the classroom. When asked who the culprit was, Dominic took the blame. This amazed the other boys in the class because Dominic hadn't gone near the stove. Dominic was paddled as punishment. Afterward the real story came out – Dominic had nothing to do with it. Regretting his previous harsh actions, the teacher asked Dominic why he had not defended himself. His answer came slowly but simply, "I knew that the other boy was in trouble for other things. I remembered how Our Lord had been unjustly accused, and I hoped that if I took the fall he would be given another chance."
